The University of Mumbai (known earlier as University of Bombay) is one of the oldest and premier Universities in India. It was established in 1857 consequent upon "Wood's Education Dispatch", and it is one amongst the first three Universities in India. It is abbreviated as MU for Mumbai University. The University was accorded 5 star status in 2001 & 'A' grade status in April 2012 by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). It has been granted University with Potential for Excellence (UPE) status by UGC and PURSE Scheme by DST. The University of Mumbai offers Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral Programmes apart from diplomas and certificates in many disciplines. More than 775 colleges in and around Mumbai are affiliated to MU and the campus located in Fort carries out administrative work only.
