CERTIFICATE IN GERMAN

The main aim of this course is to introduce the students to elementary knowledge of the language, its grammar and phonetics and shall involve diverse grammar exercises for practice. Along with the practice of German language structures, their application in authentic situations shall also be dealt with. This course shall emphasize upon communicative competence in German writing, speaking and listening skills shall be activated Reading, hearing, understanding and writing skills shall be developed.
