- 1. Students are requested to fill their examination forms through online mode from our websites http://mu.ac.in/portal/distance-open-learning/, http://idoloa.digitaluniversity.ac/
- 2. Students should scan original certificate and upload their I Card / online admission application form, Photo and signature.
- 3. List of documents to be scanned and uploaded while filling the online examination forms.
- → M.Sc (Maths) Part-I: Students should scan and upload their Part I failed marksheet and degree marksheet for those students who had not appeared for Part-I Examination and passed marksheet incase of Improvement of Class.
- → M.Sc (Maths) Part-II: Students should scan and upload their Part I Passed marksheet, Part-II fail marksheet & degree marksheet for those students who had not appeared for Part-II and Bachelor degree convocation certificate and all passed marksheet in Case of Improvement of Class & Degree convocation certificate.
- 4. Students appearing for Improvement of class should fill separate forms for Part I & II.
- * The student who are appearing for improvement of class should appear under respective ordinance:- M.Sc (Maths) 2462.
- 5. Online payment can be made through Credit/Debit Card / Net Banking.
- 6. On completion of process no need to submit hard copy of Examination form anywhere.
- 7. Students should fill up the Examination Forms personally & see to it that all details are correct before taking Printout.
- 8. Student should check the syllabus on our website.
- 9. Student appearing in Individual passing scheme has to appear as per the University Circualr No. UG/16of 2017-18 dated 28th June, 2017. Link to circular http://mu.ac.in/portal/wp-content/uploads/2014/06/Item-no-7.6-change-the-scheme-Master-of-ExaminationPG-courses.pdf
- 10. As per University circular from first half examination, 2018, the exam fees will be charged subjectwise, So students are requested to pay the fees accordingly.
- 11. Students who are filling their exam forms for the first time from our new website http://idoloa.digitaluniversity.ac/ has to register first before filling the exam forms.
- 12. Students of M.Sc. (Maths) II appeared and failed before 2007 and not filled the examination form after that, they has to pay extra charges of convocation degree certificate of Rs. 250/-.
- 13. Old students who have taken admission before 2015-16in part I and those who have taken admission before 2016-17 in part II have to fill the exam form & appear in revised 80:20 scheme with revised syllabus. Such students need not take fresh admission again.
- New Applicant: The students who are registering for the first time in IDOL & who registered in IDOL before the academic year 2017-18, have to register fresh & proceed to fill the examination form.
