A reference is invited to the Ordinances, Regulations and syllabi relating to the Bachelor of Commerce (B. Com.) degree course vide Pamphlet No. 152 and the Principals of the affiliated colleges in Commerce and Professor-cum-Director, Institute of Distance Education are hereby informed that the recommendation made by the faculty of Commerce at its meeting held on 12th March, 2009 has been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 21st April, 2009 vide Item No.4.49 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 22nd May, 2009 vide item No. 20 and that, in accordance therewith, in exercise of powers conferred upon the Management Council under Section 55(1) of the Maharashtra Universities Act,1994 it has made **Regulation 8032** relating to the Combine Passing of Commerce Accountancy and Management (Special group) paper III,IV, & V at T.Y.B.Com. examination as under :-

R. 8032: - that the student of T.Y.B.Com. who secured minimum 20 marks in any of the subject of Commerce/Accountancy and Management (Special group) paper III,IV & V and obtained 105 marks in aggregate shall be declared to have passed in the subject Commerce special group paper III/IV/V at T.Y.B.Com. examination.

Further that the above Regulation has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2009-2010.
