**Admission Schedule for the Second SPOT round for the M.Sc.
Degree (Choice Based Credit System) (CBCS) course in Chemistry**

The Second SPOT Round of admissions will be held in the **Office of the Department** on Monday, 16th September 2019 at 11.00 a.m.

The students *from all categories* who have already filled the forms, but have not been allotted any seat in the earlier round or those who have not been allotted a seat in the preferred branch in the earlier round will be considered in the Spot Round on merit basis. The students who have cancelled the allotted seat in earlier round will not be considered for the Spot Round.

Applicant who has been allotted a seat in the spot round is required to follow the following procedure strictly to confirm the admission.

1. Submit the Original Statement of Marks of T. Y. B. Sc. (Semester V and Semester VI) Examination, Other University student (Semester I to Semester VI).
2. In case of reserved category students, the original Caste Certificate and Validity should be brought for verification.
3. In case of OBC/SBC/NT/DT/SEBC candidates, a non-creamy layer certificate for the current financial year (2019-20) should be submitted in original.
4. If the candidate fails to produce the required certificates in original at the time of admission, he/she will forfeit the claim for admission.
5. The candidate will be issued four copies of the challan for payment of the prescribed fees (**For General Category: Rs.11,145/- and for Reserved Category, Rs. 1295/-**) in Allahabad Bank, Kalina Branch, Wadia High School compound, Ground Floor, Opposite Vidyanagari Campus. The candidate should pay the prescribed fees in the bank on the same or following day. Two copies of the duly stamped Challan would be returned to the student by the bank.
6. One copy of the Challan should be preserved carefully by the candidate and the other copy (Department copy) should be returned to the Department office on or before Tuesday, 17th September 2019, failing which the candidate will forfeit the claim for admission.
7. All the candidates who are admitted in the Spot Round are also required to pay refundable deposit of Rs. 800 in cash in the Department office. A separate receipt would be given to the candidate which should be preserved carefully.

The candidates admitted in the Spot Round should note that the admission process is considered to be complete only when the candidate completes all the formalities mentioned in points 1 to 7.
