Applications are hereby invited for admission into the M. A. (Honours) in English and M. A. (Honours with Research) in English programmes of the Department of English. The forms will be issued from <u>Wednesday</u>, 26th June, 2019 to 9th July, 2019 between 11.00 a.m. to 01.00 p.m. and between 02.00 p.m. to 04.00 p.m. on all weekdays and first, third and fifth Saturdays. The form fee is Rs.100/- (to be paid in cash only).

All the candidates are also required to register online on http://www.mum.digitaluniversity.ac.

Eligibility: As per the rules of University of Mumbai.

In case of students with faculty/subject change an entrance test will be held on 10th July, 2019 at 11.30 a.m.

The list of the eligible candidates will be displayed on the website and on the Notice Board of the Department on 10th July, 2019. Interviews for the selection of candidates will be held 12th July, 2019 from 10.00 a.m. onwards in the Department of English, University of Mumbai, Ranade Bhavan, Vidyanagari, Santacruz [E], Mumbai. Eligible candidates should remain present for the interview with original certificates on the date and time mentioned above.

The Merit List will be displayed on the Notice Board and the website on 15th July, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. Selected candidates should complete the admission procedure between 16th July to 20th July, 2019.

Please note that no separate communication will be sent for interviews.

- The candidates seeking admission to M. A. (Semester-I) Honours and M.A. Honours with Research in English should submit self-attested copies [with Annexure B] of the mark sheets of all the three years (i.e. F.Y; S.Y. and T.Y.B.A). They must also bring the Originals.
- All the candidates claiming the reservation for Backward Classes should produce a "Caste Certificate" in the name of the candidate issued by the Competent Authority in Maharashtra State clearly mentioning the Category of the candidate and also the remark that the caste is considered as Backward Class in the state of Maharashtra at the time of submission of admission form.
- The candidates belonging to NT1, NT2, NT3, OBC categories should produce latest "Non Creamy Layer Certificate" issued by Sub Divisional Officer/Deputy Collector of the district in addition to the caste certificate. In case these candidates failed to produce the latest "Non Creamy Layer certificate" at the time of submission of application form, they will be treated as General category candidates.
- The category of Physically Disadvantaged should be mentioned on the form and the required certificate/s should be submitted.

Students belonging to Universities other than the University of Mumbai should submit self-attested copies [with Annexure - B] of all the three year B.A. mark sheets. They must bring the originals. If selected they must submit Transfer and Migration Certificates.
