

The students shall be exposed not only to the theory and in-depth practical aspects of law but also to the various facets of management and corporate culture. The course shall prepare the students to meet the growing competition in the market post completion of the course. It will enable the students to have an upper edge over others in the field.



## **COURSE HIGHLIGHTS:**

1. The Integrated Five Years B.B.A LL.B (Hons.) Course provides students with an all-inclusive knowledge of law and management.
2. Develops and polishes the skills and abilities vital for legal professionals and corporates.
3. Lays prominence on developing and fine-tuning advocacy and management skills.
4. Establishes learning through lectures and encourages involvement of students through innovative teaching methods such as projects, role play, debates, problem solving, individual and group presentations as well as co-curricular and extra- curricular activities.
5. Opportunity for students to actively participate in social justice and access to justice forums at State, National and International levels.
6. Major thrust on Clinical Legal Education programme, where students learn theoretical concepts through practical work and experience, thus, bridging the gaps between theory and practice.

### **DURATION & STRENGTH:**

Five years Full-Time Course with 60 seats per academic batch.

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

A candidate passing the H.S.C. (10+2) examination conducted by the Maharashtra State Board Of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, with minimum 45% marks or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto by the University of Mumbai with the minimum prescribed marks is eligible for admission to the First Year of Five Year Law Course. The above percentage of marks shall be relaxed by 5% for candidates belonging to the SC & ST categories as per reservation policy prescribed and recognized by the Government of Maharashtra.

### **ADMISSION PROCEDURE:**

The admissions to UMLA shall be based on merit in the Maharashtra State Common Law Entrance Test [MHCET-Law].

Admission process for the first year of the Five year B.B.A. LLB (Hons.) course will commence immediately after the declaration of MHCET results. Reservation of 85% seats for candidate from the State of Maharashtra having the Domicile Certificate.

The Prospectus and the registration forms will be available at the UMLA office. The admission form along with the required documents, duly filled in, should be submitted to the college within the prescribed time as per the MHCET admission process.

### **RESERVATION AND OTHER ASPECTS**

The matter of reservations for the candidates falling within the categories of S.C., S.T., O.B.C., S.B.C., etc. is in accordance with the relevant Government Resolutions issued by the State of Maharashtra.

### **DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION PROCESS:**

1. Passing certificate and certified copy of a document indicating the date of birth, for example, school leaving certificate.
2. Documents include SSC Mark sheet & Certificate, HSC Mark sheet & Certificate, College leaving Certificate, Domicile/Nationality Certificate, CET Score Card, CET Hall Ticket/CET Application Form, Option Form, NC in case of lost CET hall ticket, Allotment Letter, Caste Certificate( SC/ST/DT/VJ/NT-A,B,C,D, OBC and SCB, Non Creamy Certificate(OBC), Performa H & Aadhar Card.
3. In case of students, from other colleges affiliated to the Mumbai University, who seeks admission, Transfer Certificate (T.C.) is required to be submitted. The applications for such T.C. should be sent through this college in the prescribed form.
5. Two recent passport size photographs.
6. At the time of admission, every student must undertake to attend a minimum 75% of the total number of lectures held in each semester. Failure to comply with the same shall result in such defaulting students getting debarred from appearing at the examination and their names shall be duly displayed on office board/s and shall also be put up on the UMLA website.
