

## ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE SECOND ROUND OF PROGRAMMES FOR THE YEAR 2018-19:

### SHASTRI INDO-CANADIAN INSTITUTE

Shastri Indo-Canadian Institute has announced its **second round** of programmes for the year **2018-19**. SICI, India office invites applications for grants from scholars/faculty/educational administrators. Besides university departments, institutes and conducted colleges, all the colleges affiliated to the University of Mumbai are eligible to apply. Applicants are encouraged to submit proposals timely to avoid last minute rush. The last minute submission creates pressure on the Grant Management System (**GMS**) which results in slow processing or inactive sessions.

7. Faculty-In-Residence Programme (**FIR**)/ Global Initiative For Academic Network (**GIAN**)
8. Shastri Scholar Travel Subsidy Grant (**SSTSG**)
9. Shastri Student Internship Project (**SSIP**)
10. SICI Membership Development Fund (**SMDF**)
11. Faculty Development Programme For Vocational Education (**FDPVE**)

In general applications from all domains of studies like Social Sciences and Humanities, Arts, Commerce & Management and STEM subjects are accepted. However, applications are encouraged in the focus areas of SICI and priority areas of MHRD, Govt. of India i.e. Food Security and Sustainable Development, Energy, Environmental Science and Climate Change, Agricultural Science & Technology, Health Care Sciences, Nursing, Marine Sciences and Ocean Studies, Information & Communication Technology, Sustainable Habitat, Nano-technology Hardware, Water Resources & River Systems, Advanced Materials, Manufacturing, Security & Defence, Gender, Bi-lateral Trade and Investment, Securing Future of Children and Youth, Higher Education, Teacher Education and Training. **Deadline to submit applications may vary according to the programme.
