- Boarding facilities should be available so as to provide food for participants at their own
- Judges for the competition will be appointed by the Department of Students' Development
- Expenses on make-up/special light effects/special sound effects, etc. will be borne by the participating colleges.
- The arrangement of papers, clay, magazines for collage and other materials (except colours) will be made available by the Department of Students' Development for Fine Art
