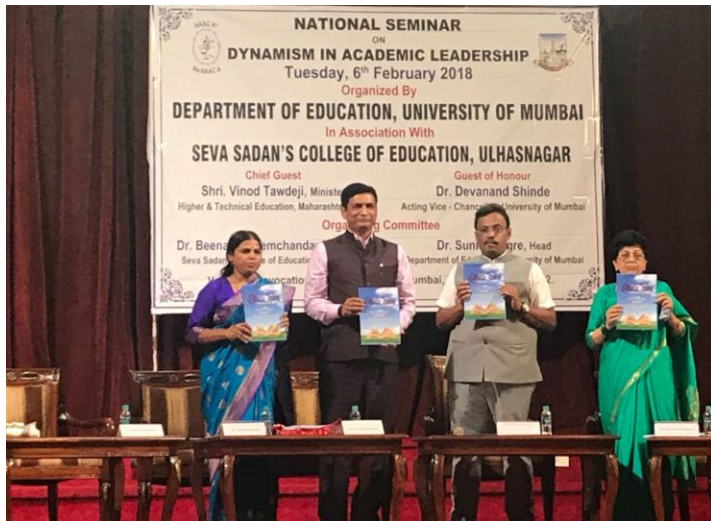

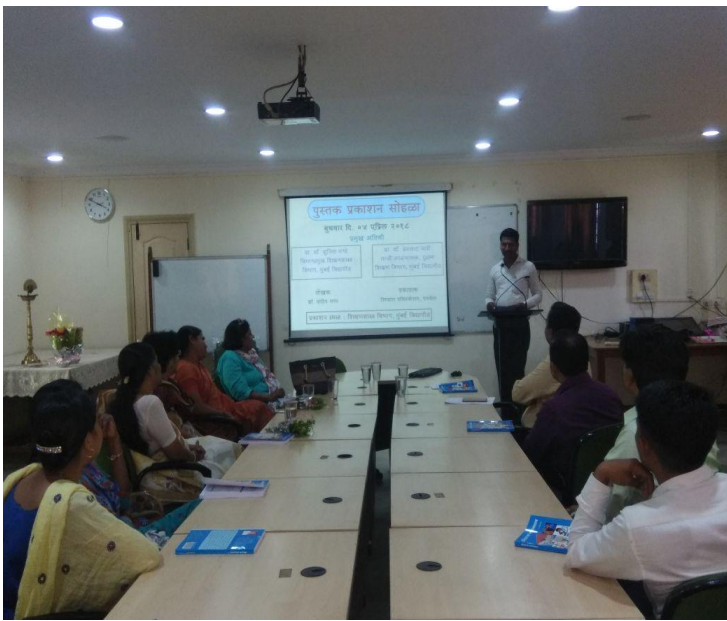


BOOK RELEASE FUNCTION APRIL 4, 2018

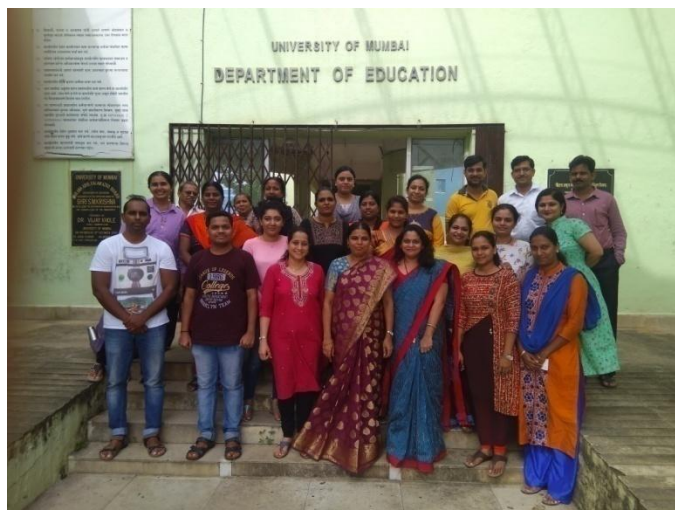
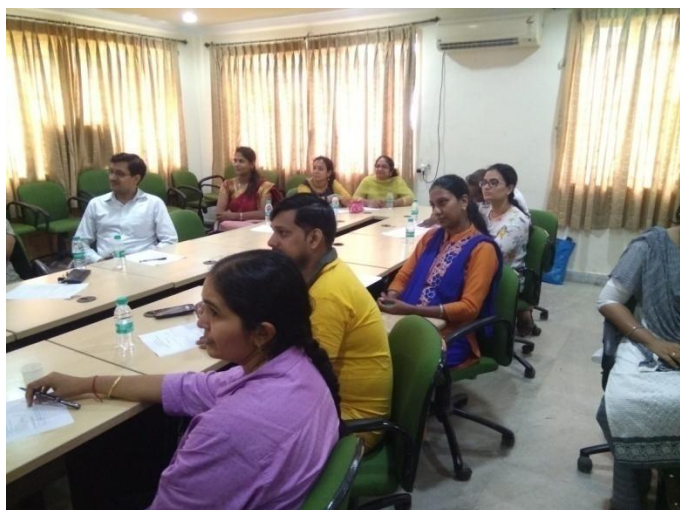

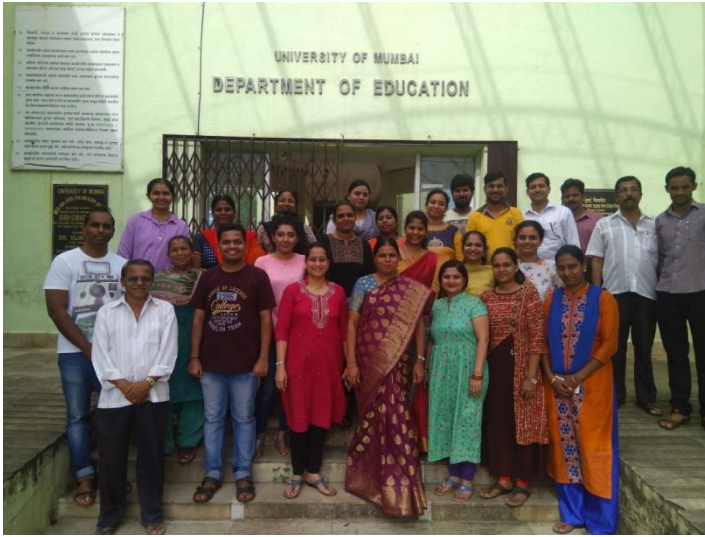

Inaugural Session:-

Dr. Sunita Magre, Head Department of education welcomed all the guests and presented a bouquet as token of love to resource person Ms. Haritha, Program Coordinator for Maharashtra from Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Development, Hyderabad. Session I (Pre Lunch Session)

Session I began with the theoretical aspect of NaiTalim as proposed and practiced by Mahatma Gandhi. Ms. Haritha gave very good and real examples and advocated the need of Experiential Learning. After a good discussion one Individual activity was given to the participants where they were expected to write down the Topics, Activities and Evaluation Technique in their respective subjects suitable for Experiential learning from classes Pre-school to Std XII. Few very good activities were suggested for e.g. for standard VI English subject, Letter Writing activity was suggested in a novel way. Students may be taken to a village to find out the local problems through home visits of villagers and then they can write a letter to the authorities for solving the problems of the villagers.

One more activity suggested in Geography for the topic Map was to ask the students to draw a map of their home/ classroom first and then proceed for other maps. Then it was the lunch break that provided the opportunity to enjoy lovely food and at the same time socialization of participants.

Session II (Post Lunch Session)

Soon after the lunch break, without wasting time the Session II began by discussing Experiential Learning Activity Plans for School Curriculum and B.Ed curriculum. Handouts were given to all

the participants which served as a model for them. Four groups were formed. They chose to be labelled themselves as Einstein, Gandhiji, NaiTalim and Super Hero groups. A group activity was given to the participant. Each group was asked to prepare an Experiential Learning Activity Plan for School Curriculum and B.Ed. curriculum. The Plan included the name of the activity, Steps, Precautions, Tools, Checklist and Assessment Technique. They were also instructed to represent the plans through a chart. Groups worked with team spirit, cooperation and enthusiasm. Half an hour was allotted to brainstorm, discuss, finalise, jot down and prepare plans and charts. It was followed by a brief Tea-Break. 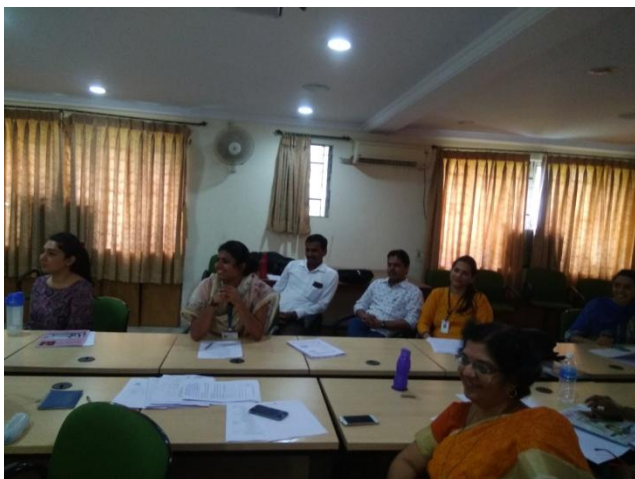
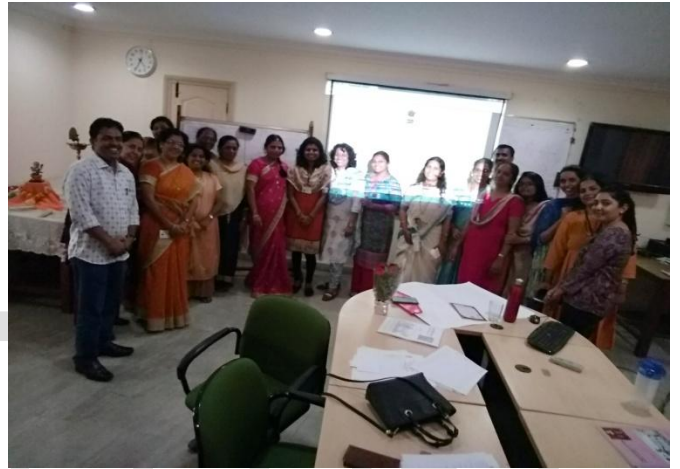
Valedictory Session:-

SESSION BY DR. USHARAO

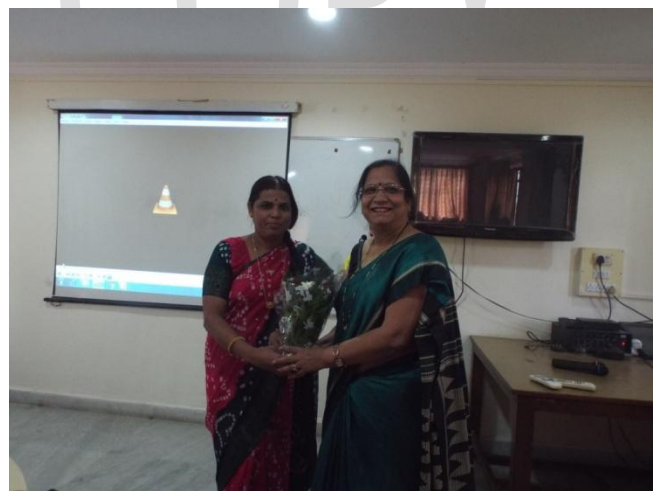
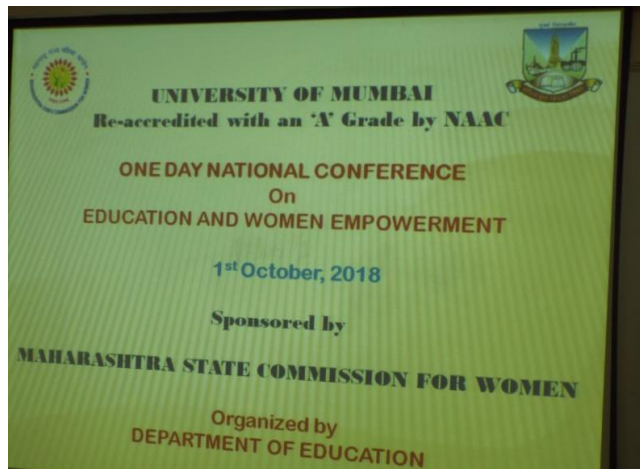

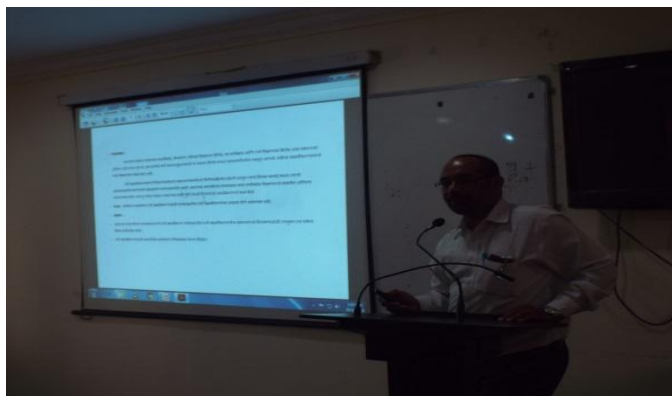
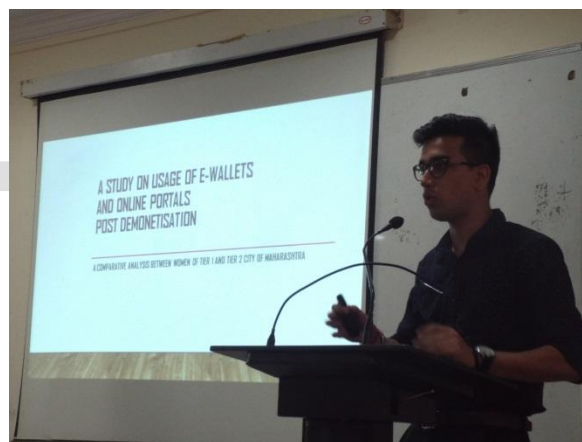
VALEDICTORY SESSION ADDRESS BY MS. UJJAWALA HAWARE

NOVEMBER 17, 2018

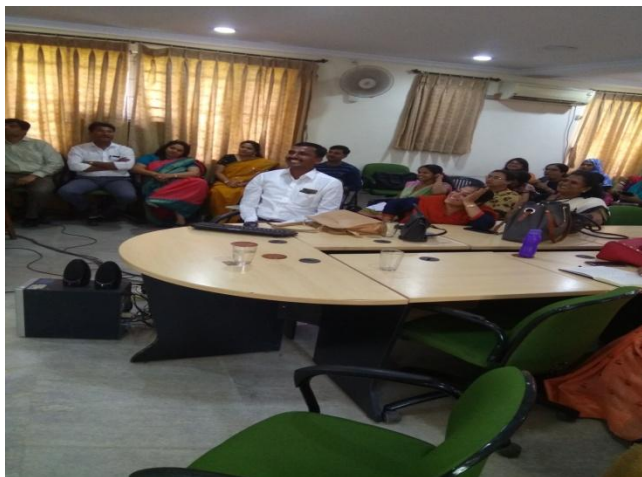
