What Kind of Papers can be submitted?

Researchers are invited to submit a research proposal/research synopsis/manuscript that would highlight any one of the following areas;

- Modern trends in the approaches to research – Opportunities, Challenges and Issues,
- Unique findings / assertions – Applicability for Practitioners and further Research,
- Research proposal/research synopsis/manuscript in the areas of ; School Education; Teacher Education; Educational Management; Economics of Education; Education and Society,
- Relevance, opportunities and challenges of the research findings of your study,
- Analysis strategies – Uniqueness, fitness of purpose, validity and challenges,
- Varied Styles of Communicating Research Results.

Presentations will be arranged for discussions after the Key note talks in each area. Language for Presentation and submission of Paper should be either in English or Marathi (Font -Shivaji).

Format for submissions

The proposal/synopsis/manuscript must be written as a Word document (M.S Office 2007), with your name as the filename, and be up to 1500 words in length, with the following suggested sub-headings as appropriate:

- Abstract up to 300 words,
- Introduction : The Area under which this paper belongs (refer to kinds of research papers above),
- Research objectives/questions and goals,
- Description of method used/proposed to be used,
- Findings/assertions if research has been completed,
- List of probable questions that the researcher would like to raise for discussion(minimum Two maximum Five),
- Potential application of results in the field of education & References.

Presentations of proposals and manuscripts for discussions will be conducted in groups with an expert to moderate.

For whom is the Researchers' Meet?

The Researcher's Meet is for teachers (mainly pursuing research after their Ph.D and Ph.D. students) working in the field of education, who are passionate to see the relationship between education and practice.

Why Researchers' Meet?

This Meet is an attempt to bring researchers and academicians together to present their work in the presence of their peer audience, where discussions are encouraged. It will address challenges and recent developments in the theoretical assumptions of research (Ontological, Epistemological, Axiological and Methodological), the methodological movements in research (quantitative tradition, qualitative and mixed method tradition) and analysis strategies of research.

What does it entail?

Talk

Keynote talks at the beginning of each session are intended to provide the participants with an overview of the field, an introduction to the theoretical framework, the current trends and most importantly to highlight questions that can lead to discussions.

The talks will be divided into five thematic sessions:

The proposal/synopsis/manuscript abstract (max 300 words) should be sent on or before **10th December 2016**. Final Paper has to be sent on or before **20th December 2016**.
