- 4. All cyclists are informed that Helmet is compulsory.
- 5. Without College staff cyclist will not be permitted to take part in competition. They should bring with them their I.D. of the current session duly sign by the Principal. Postponements will under no circumstances be granted.
- 6. The Management reserves the right to change the programme of fixture as and when it deems necessary.
- 7. Team/Individual must accompany with their college Sports Director/Sports
 In charge otherwise team will not allow to take part in Inter-Collegiate
