

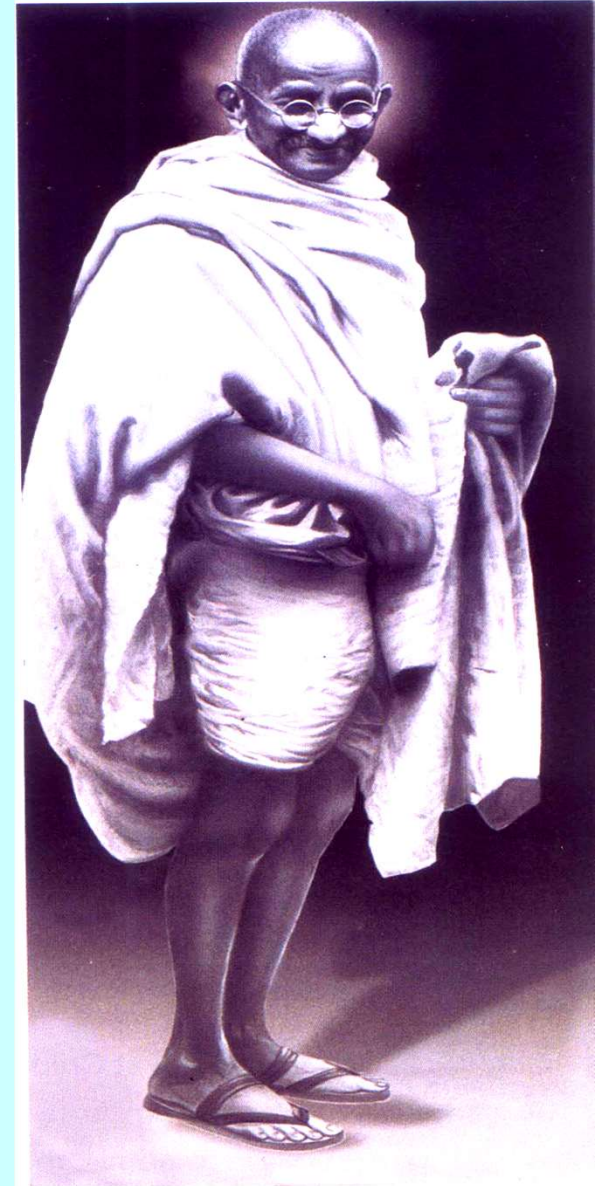

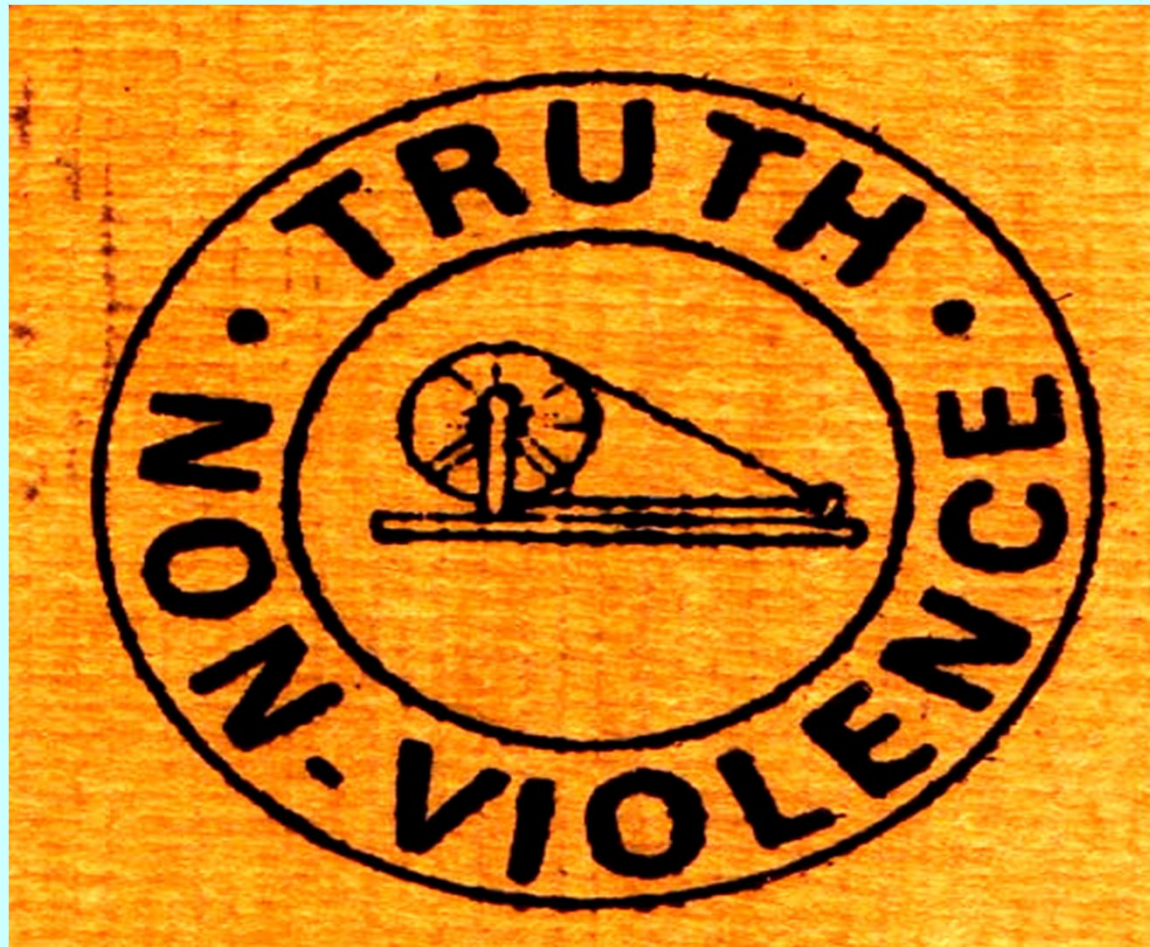

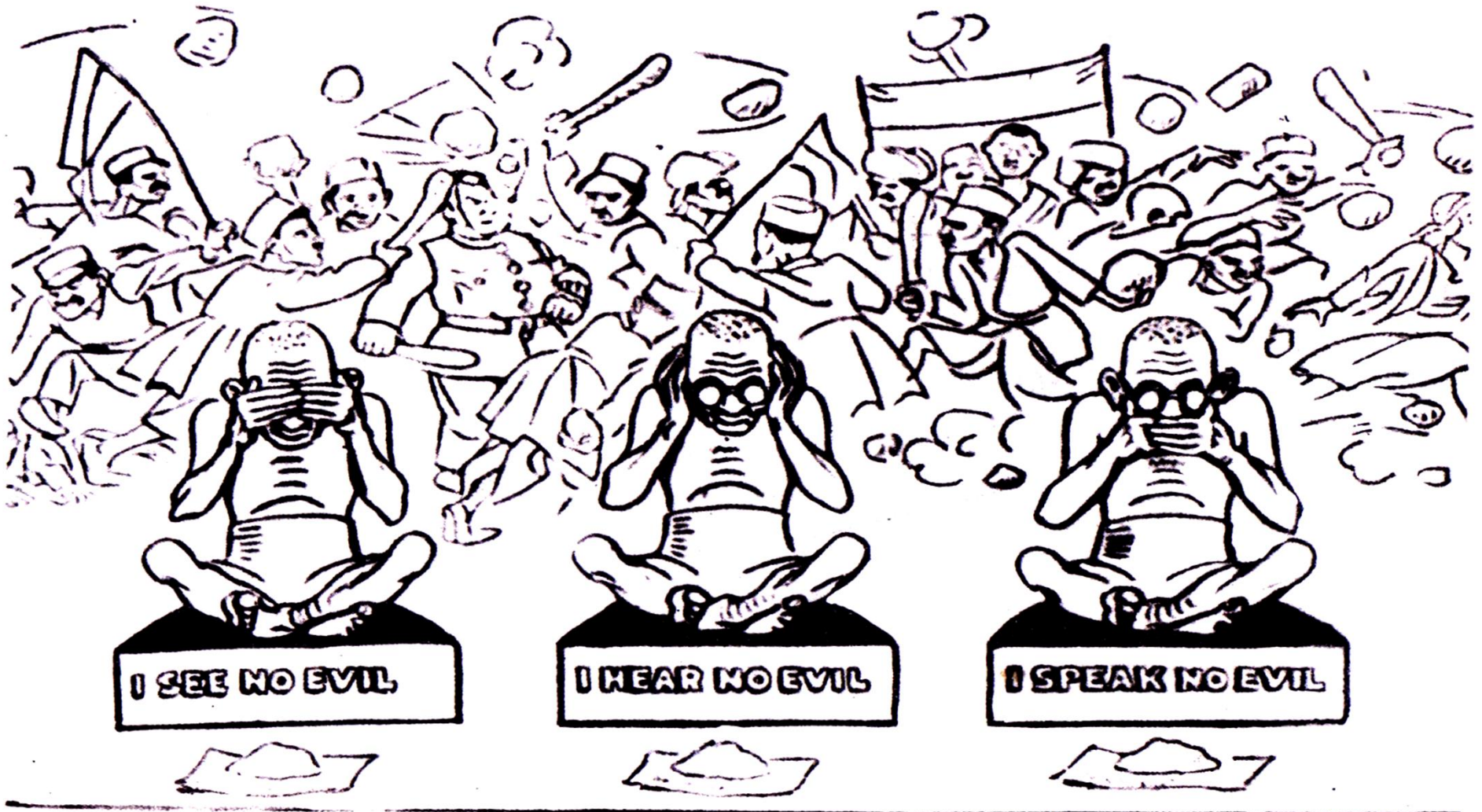

# First Stamp, India

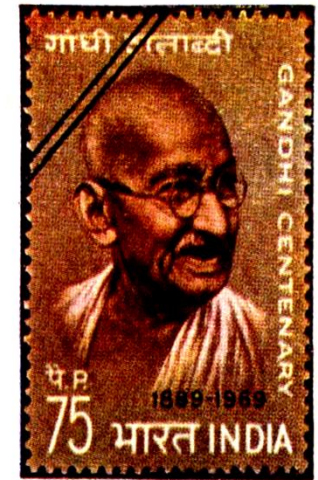
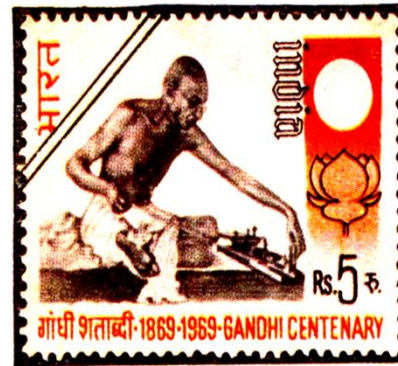

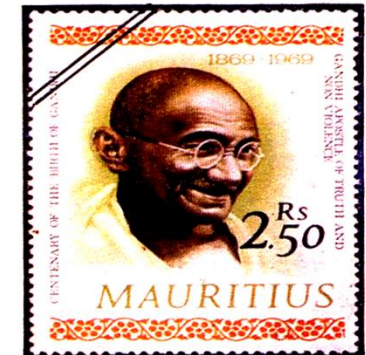

- Apostel of truth and Non Violence.





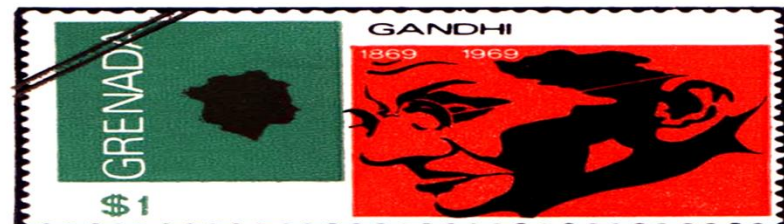
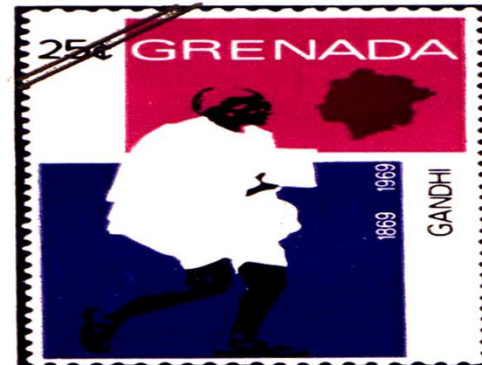

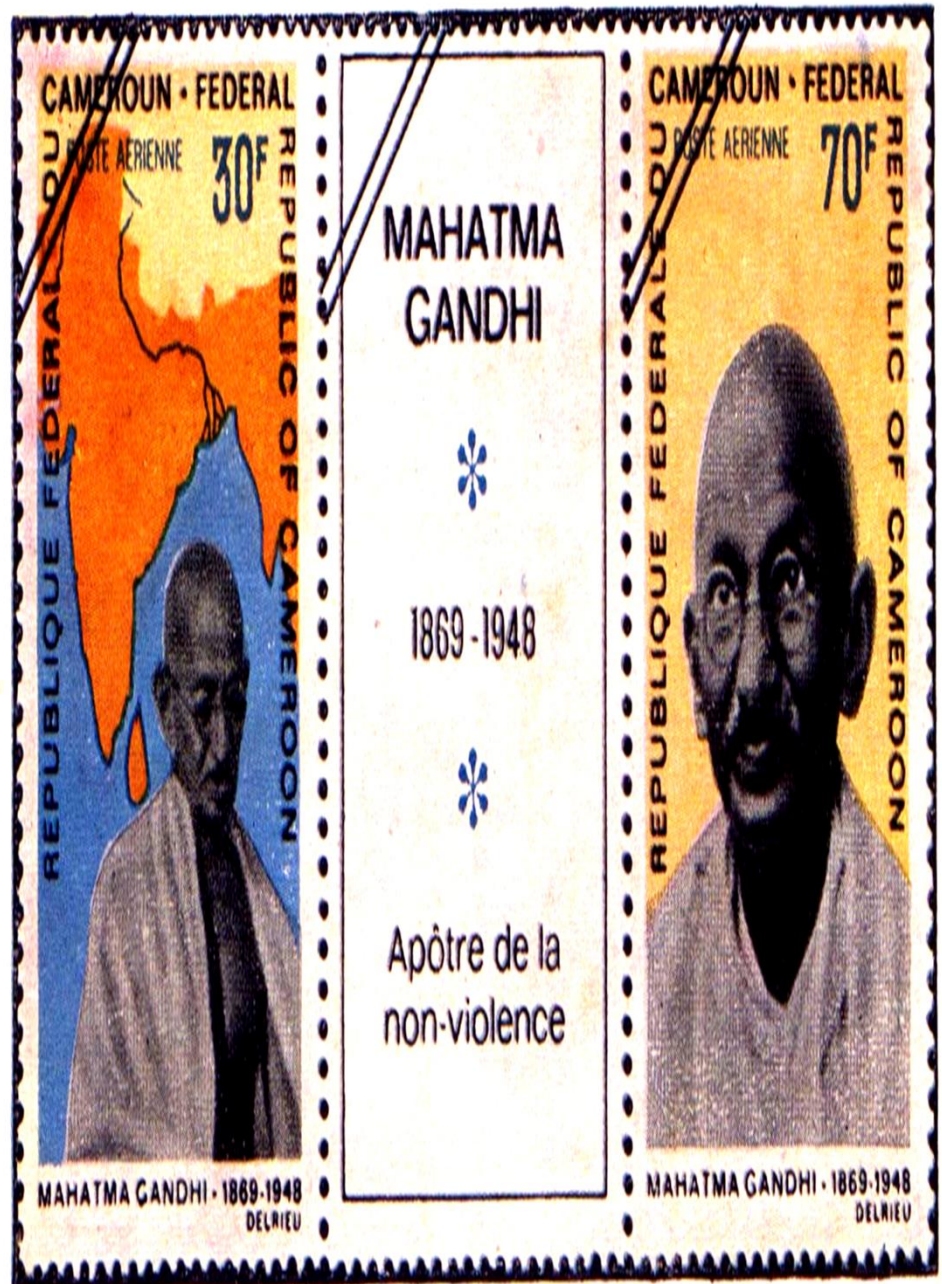

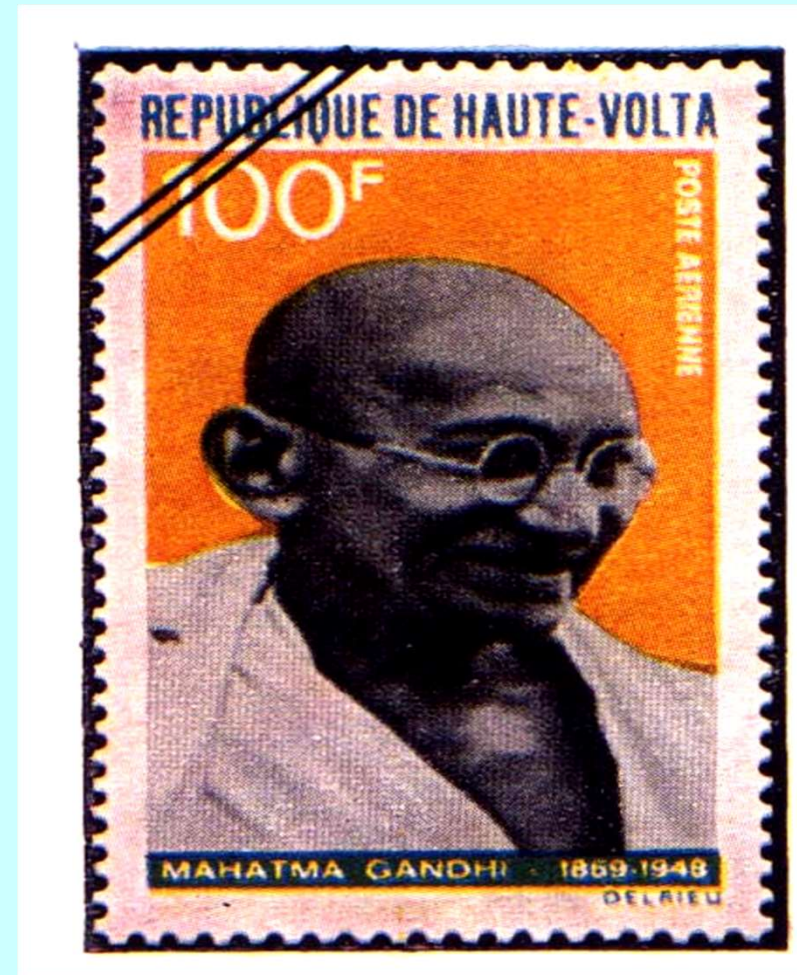

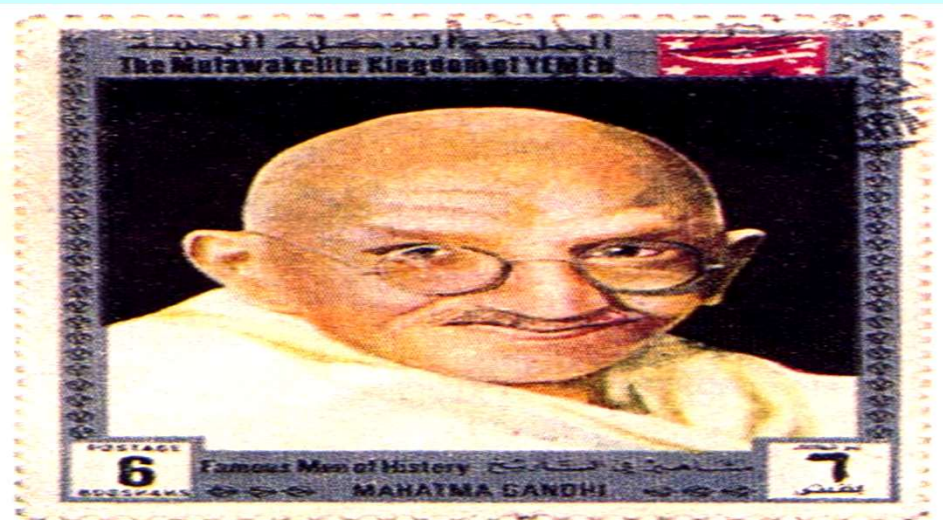

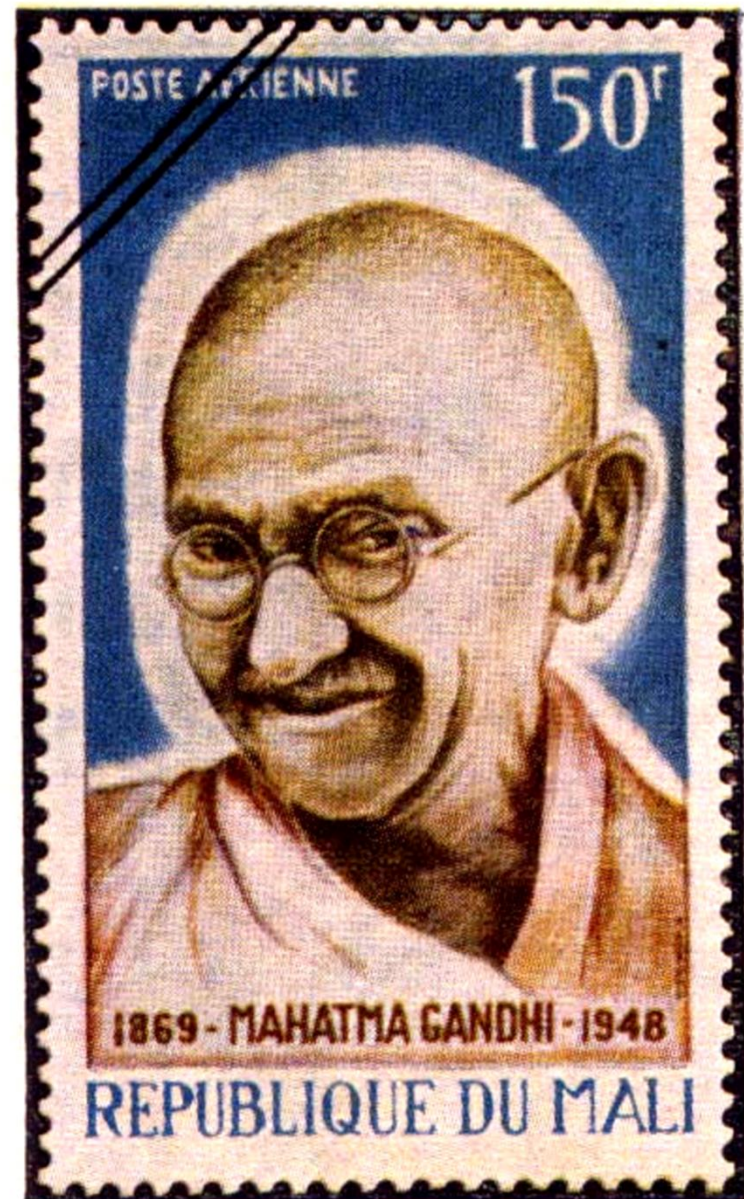

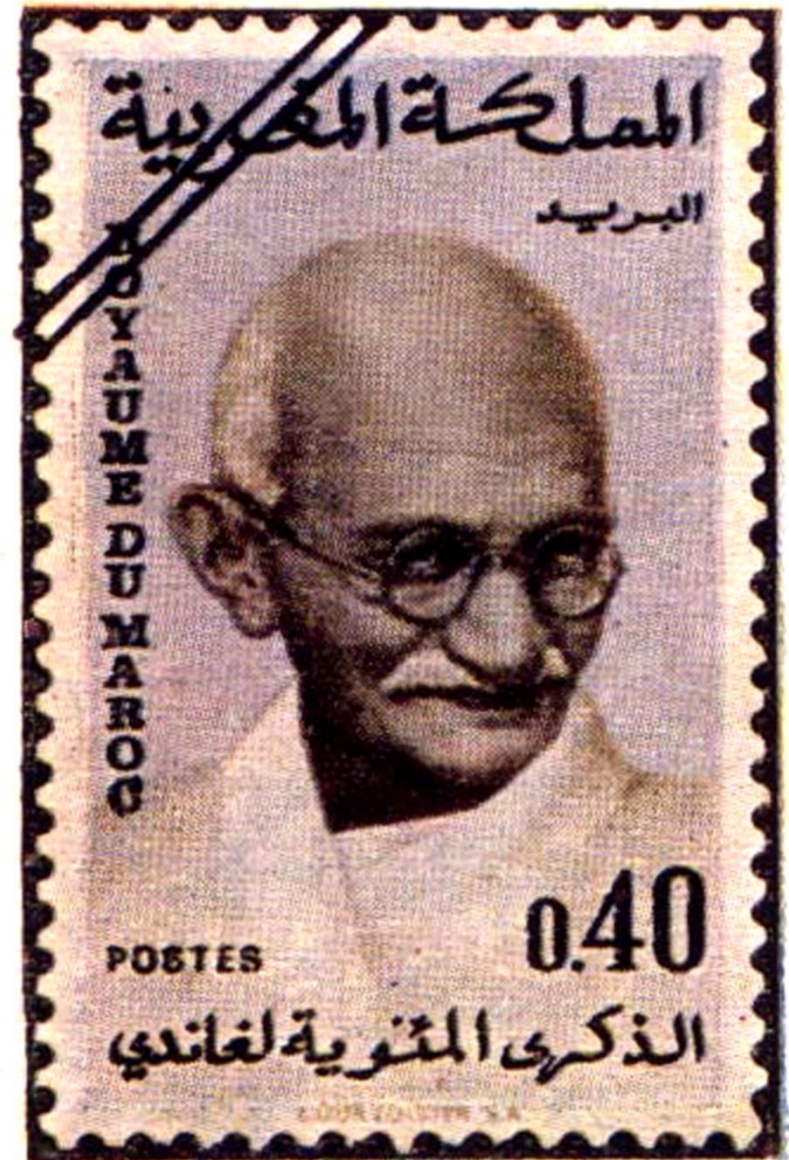

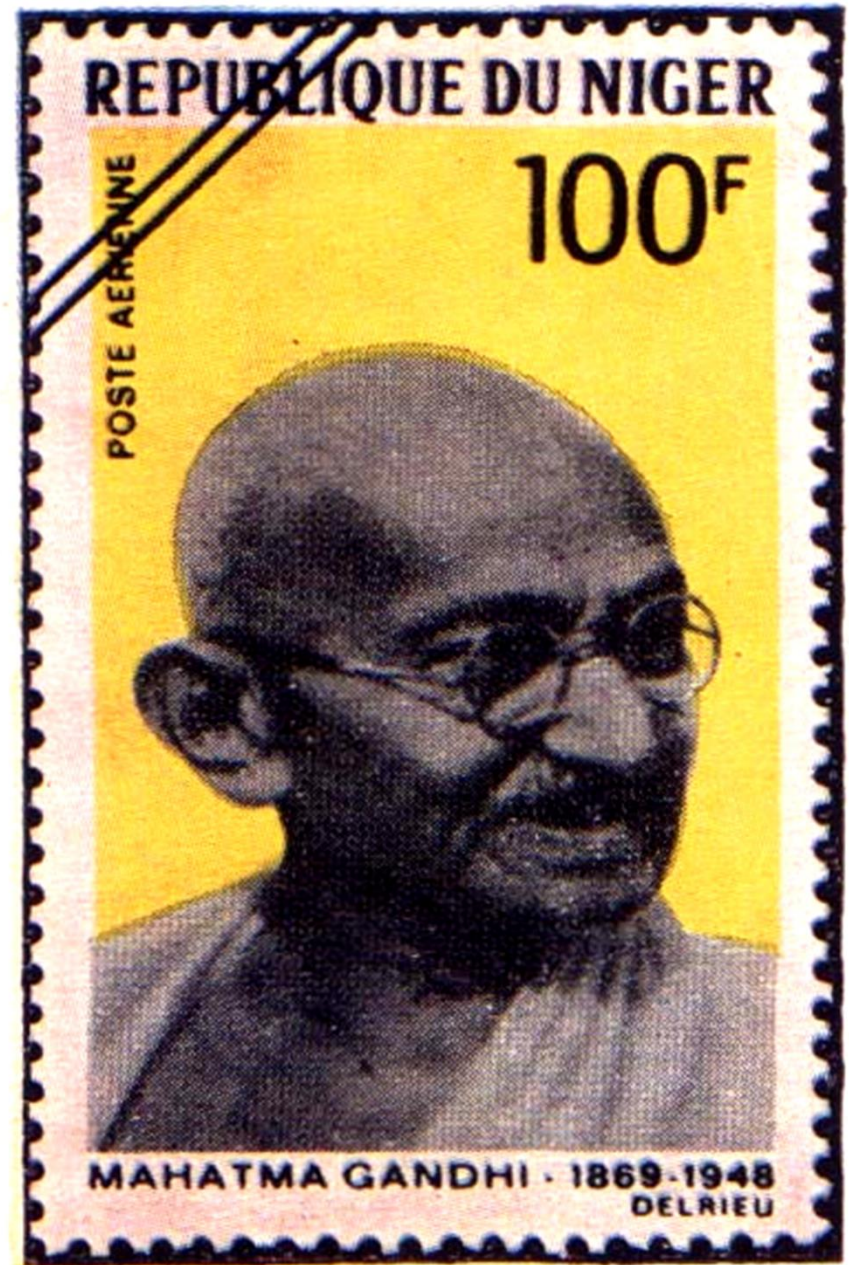

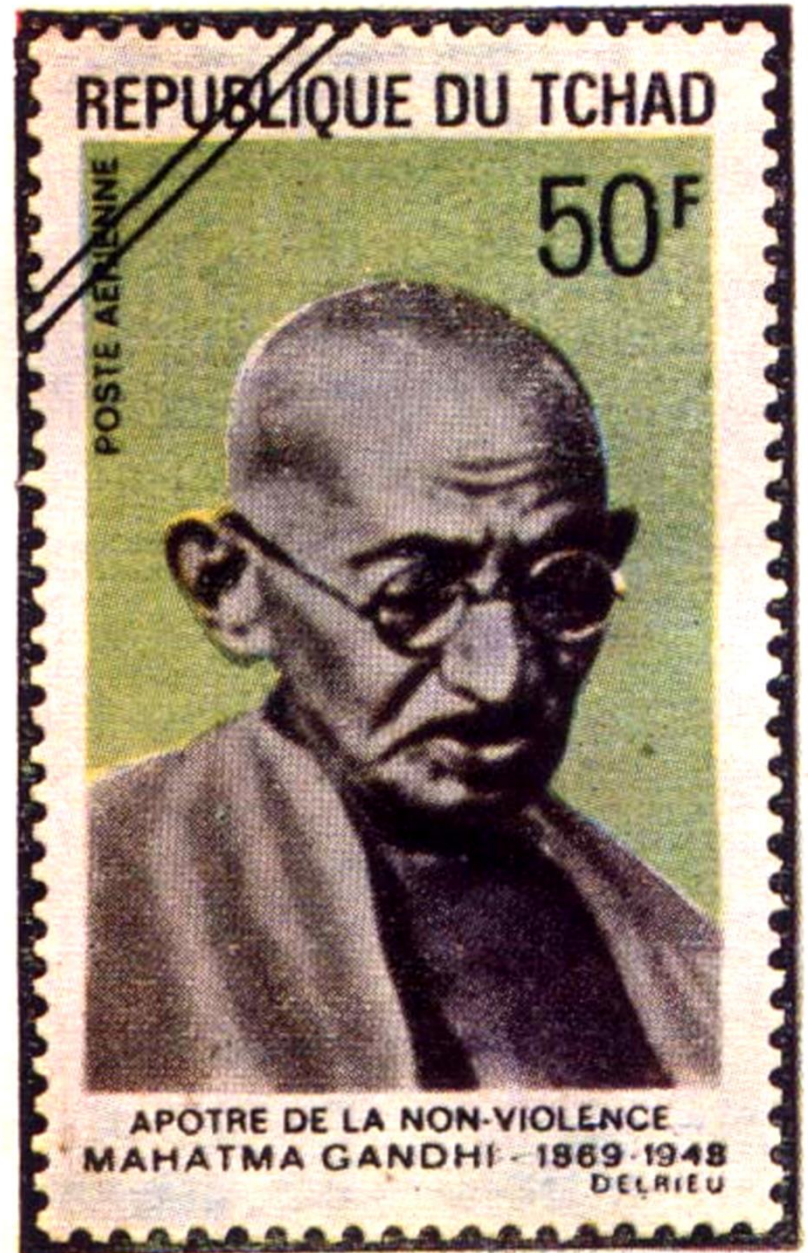

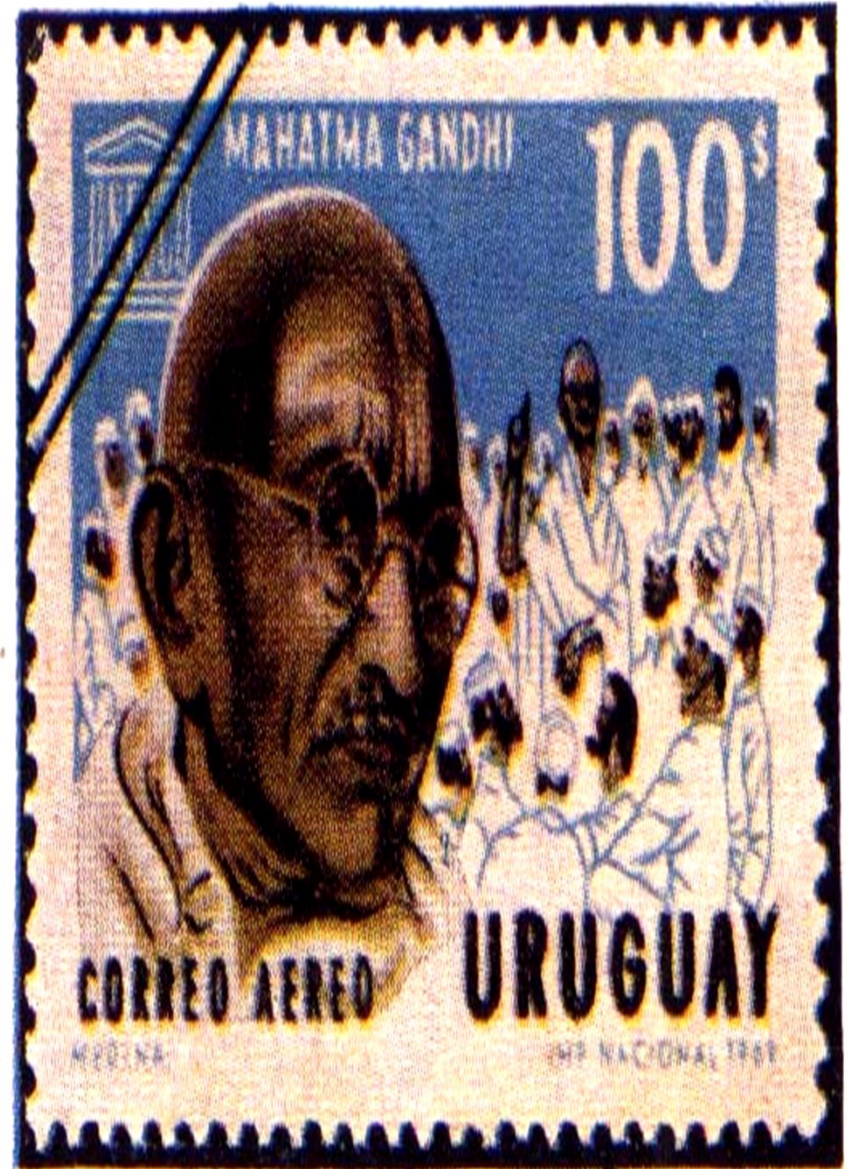

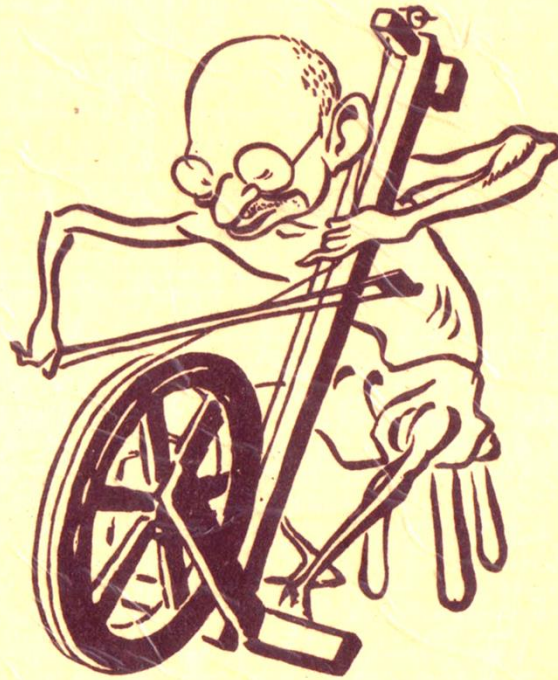

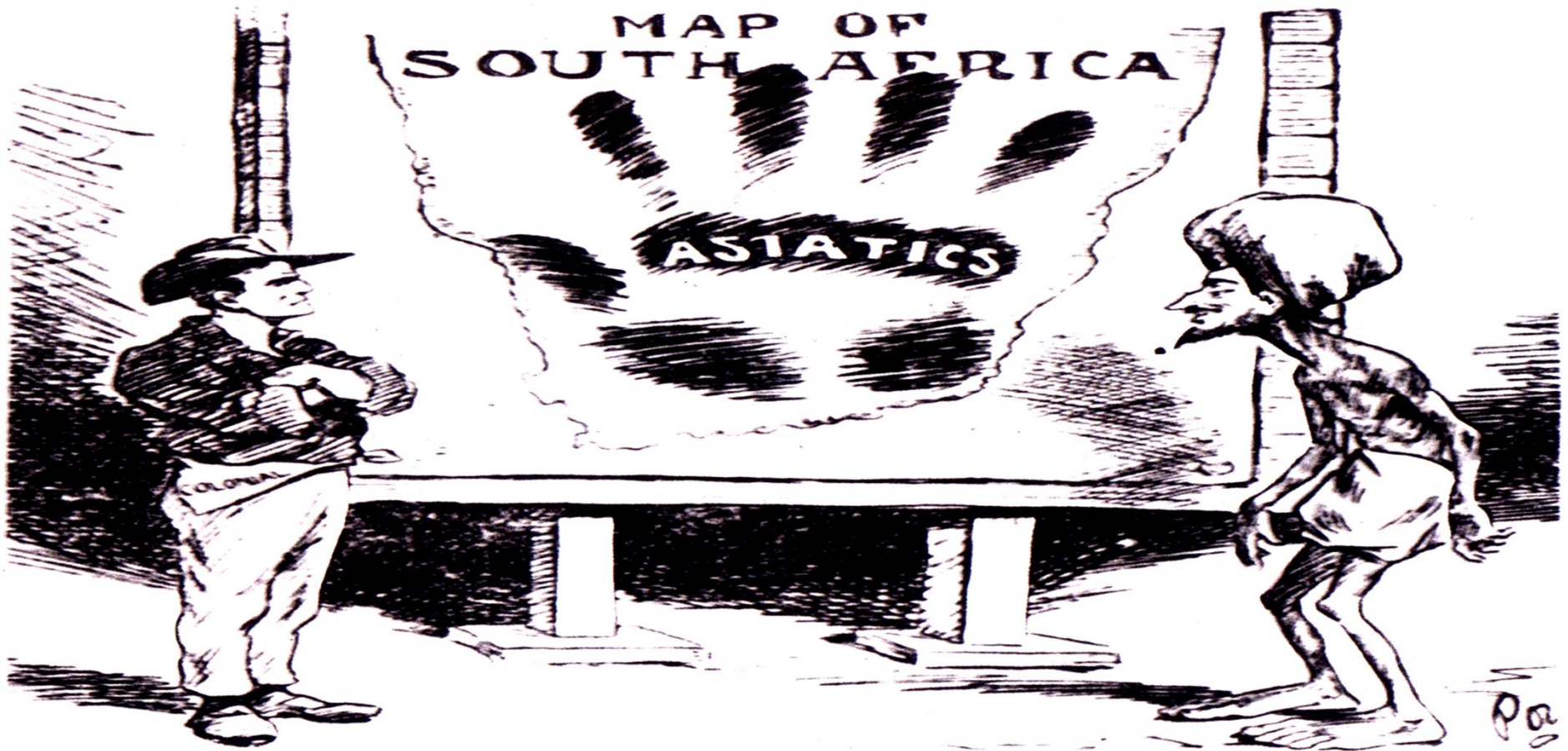

**After Registration Act of 1907 in Transvaal compelling people of Asian Origin to take out Certificates of Registration which bore thumbprints**



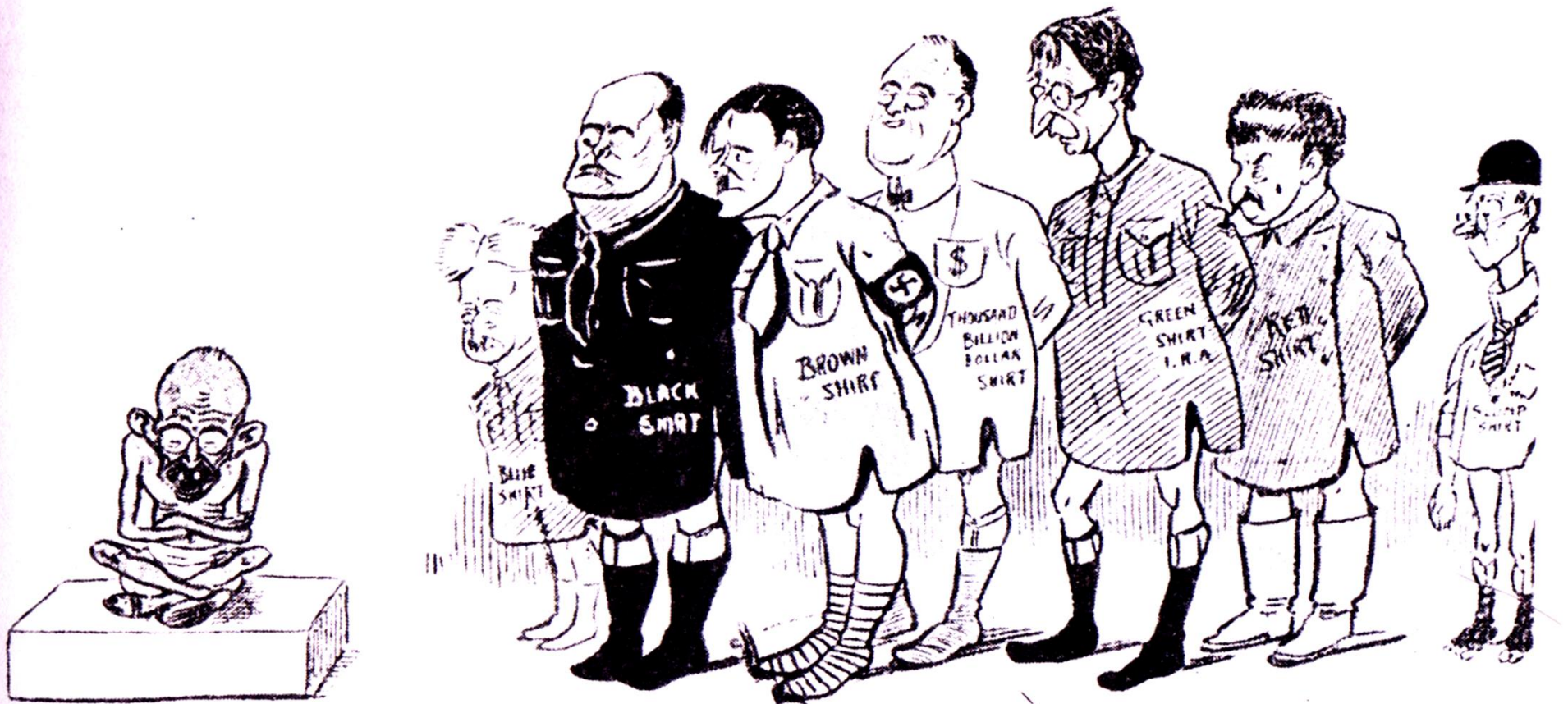
**THE FINGER-PRINT QUESTION**

Colonial: "If you feel aggrieved over these finger-prints, how do you think I feel?"



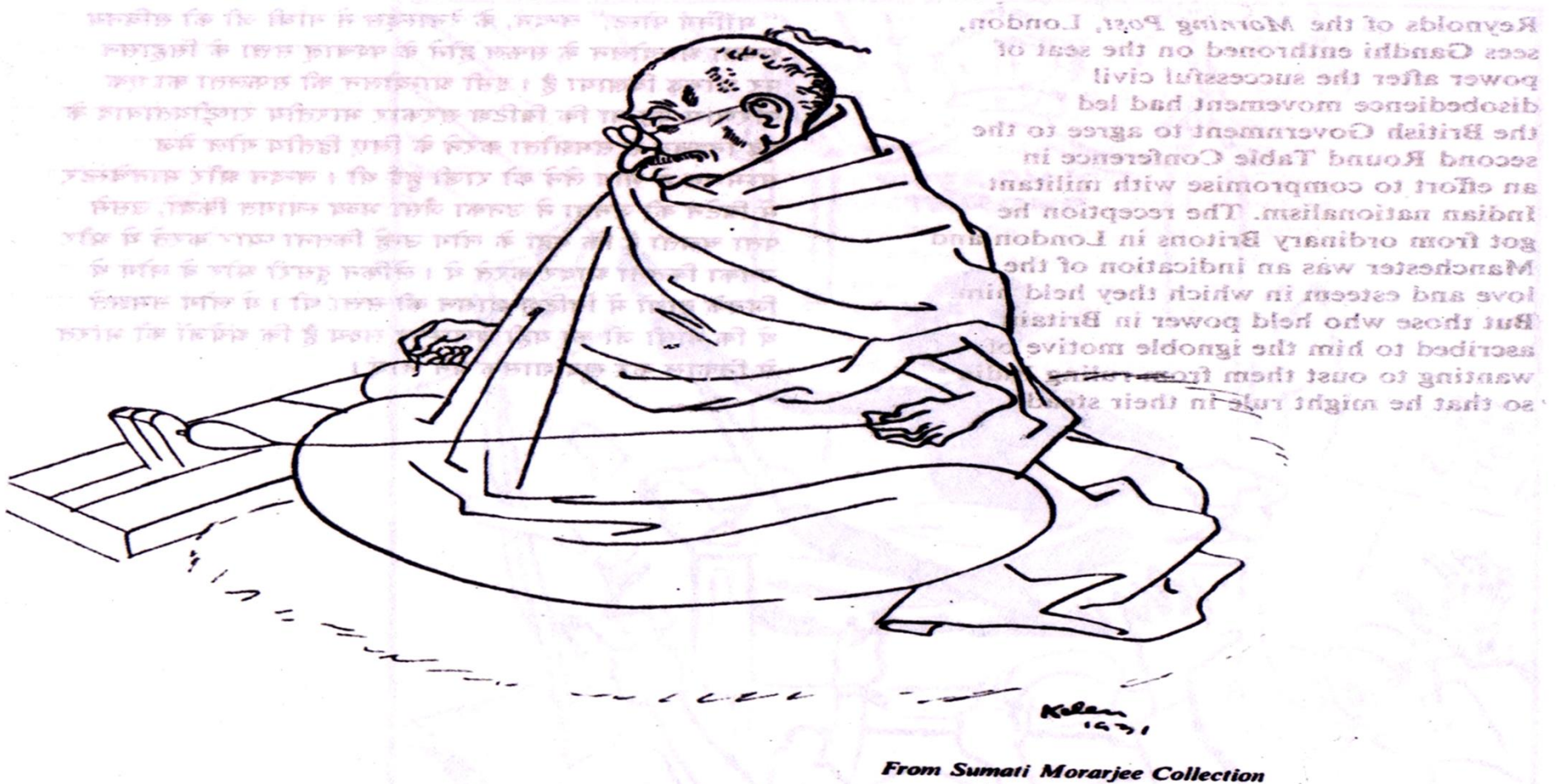
**This cartoon shows world political movements of 1931, Gandhi is shown as bare-chested. This was a cartoon from New Zealand**

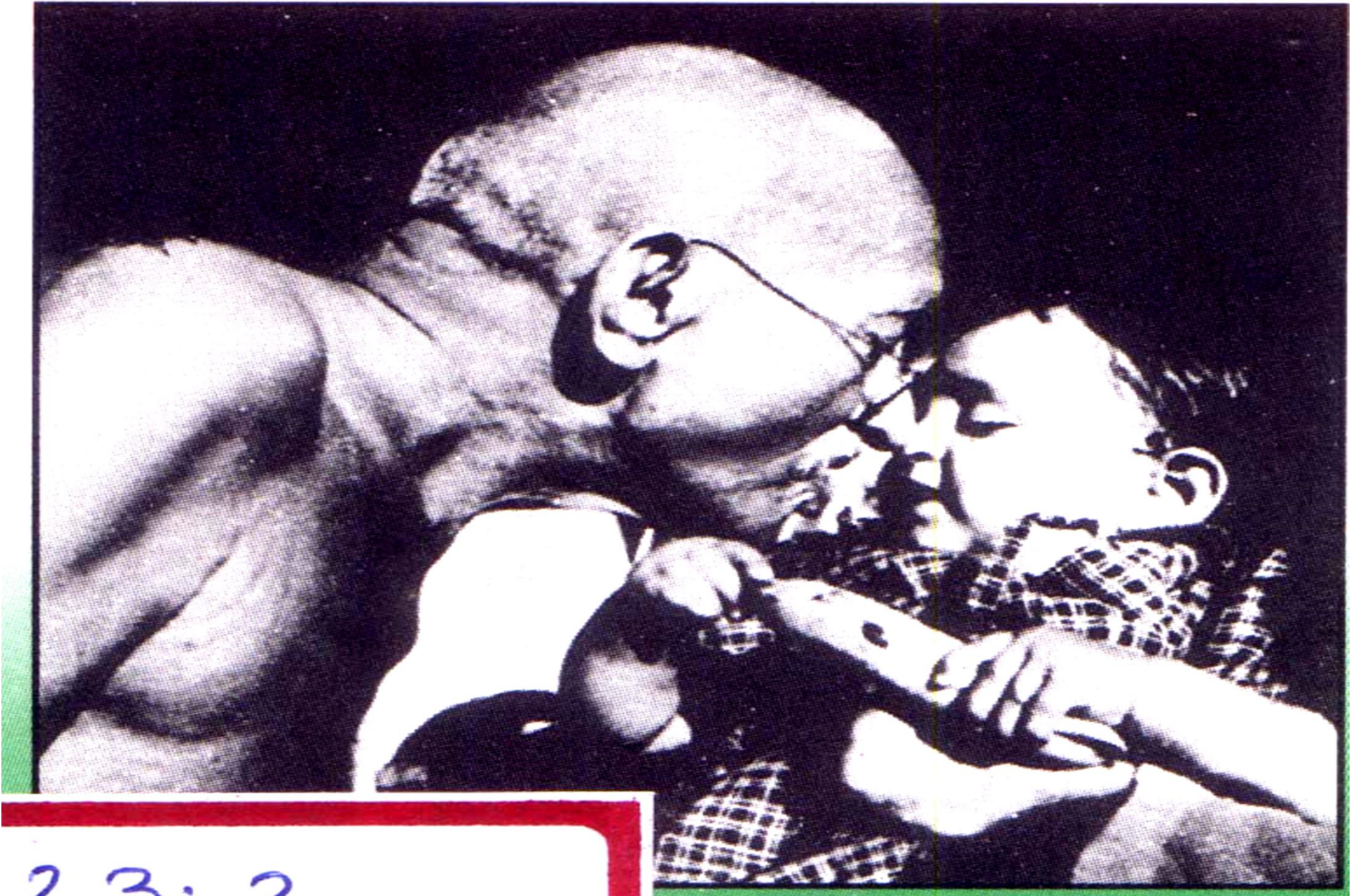
