
**CIRCULAR:-**

They are hereby informed that the recommendations made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in German at its meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2017, have been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2017 vide item No. 4.22 and that in accordance therewith, the Regulation No. 4121 relating to passing marks for Diploma in Japanese be amended, has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2017-18, accordingly. 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

**3. Revision of syllabus and passing marks for Diploma in Japanese.**

**Existing R. 4121:**

A candidate must obtain 40% of the full marks in the written and oral examinations separately and 50% in the aggregate.

**Amended R. 4121:**

A candidate must obtain 50% of the full marks in the written and oral examinations separately and 50% in the aggregate.
