CIRCULAR:-

Attention of the Principals of the Affiliated College in Social Work and the Faculty of Arts is invited to this office circular No.UG/96 of 2012-13 dated 5th December, 2012 relating to the Standard of Passing of Diploma in Social Work. They are hereby informed that the recommendations made by the Ad-Hoc Board of Studies in Social Work under the Faculty of Humanities at its meeting held on 15th July, 2017 have been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 30th July, 2017 vide item No. 4.31 and subsequently approved by the Management Council at its meeting held on 28th November, 2017 vide item No.03 and that in accordance therewith, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Management Council under Section 74 (4) of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 (Mah. Act No.VI of 2017) that the Standard of Passing of Diploma in Social Work, is amended, has been brought into force with effect from the academic year 2017-18, accordingly. The same is available on the University's website www.mu.ac.in.

Amended Passing Structure:

R.5093:

The candidate will be declared passed when he or she obtains internal and external total minimum marks of 40 percent out of 100 marks allotted to each paper.

The candidates who have failed in any paper may claim exemption in the other papers where they have obtained minimum marks of 40 percent out of the total marks allotted to that paper.

The candidate who have failed in the first attempt and passed in the second subsequent attempt will be declared to have passed in 'P' grade. The candidate who have passed in the theory papers but not have passed in field work project will have to repeat the entire field work project hours and appear for the viva voce examination.

Students must complete the diploma course with a period of 3 years from the time to registration for the course failing which the student will have re-registrar.
