

CIRCULAR:-

The Directors/Heads of the University Departments, Principals /Deans of the affiliated Colleges and the Directors of the recognised Institutions concerned are hereby informed that the Management Council at its meeting held on 31st October, 2000 (vide item No.27) approved the following resolution made by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 12th October, 2000 (vide item No. 5.1.)

- - - - the O.92 relating to Post-graduate Merit Scholarship and Free Studentship be amended to read as under and that the same be brought into force with effect from the academic year 2000-2001:-

0.92. :- University shall utilize 20% of the tuition fees received by it for the award of Merit Scholarship and further 10% for the award of Free Studentship to the Post-graduate eligible candidates.

Further, that the Management Council may award a Free Studentship or Free Studentships, if available, to those who apply for Merit Scholarship in case the number of applicants for Merit Scholarships are more than the number of Merit Scholarship available for award, or vice-versa as per the following provision.

(A) MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

- 1) The Merit Scholarship shall be an amount of Rs. 1500/- per annum or an amount fixed by the Management Council from time to time.
- 2) The applicants who have passed the last qualifying examination in the faculties of Arts, Fine Arts, Commerce or Law with minimum 55% and above marks in aggregate at the first attempt and those who have passed the last qualifying examination other than the faculties of Arts, Fine Arts, Commerce or Law with minimum 60% and above marks in aggregate at the first attempt shall be considered for the award of Merit Scholarship, as per provision.

(B) FREE STUDENTSHIP

- 1) The Free Studentship shall be equal to the tuition fee prescribed by the University from time to time but shall not exceed an amount of Merit Scholarship.
- 2) The applicant whose monthly family income does not exceed Rs.7500/- shall be considered for the award of Free Studentship.

3) The application in such cases shall be considered only if accompanied by an income certificate issued by the concerned competent authority of the Government.

4) The candidates receiving any other Freeship or course fee shall not be considered for the award of Free Studentship. Candidates from the reserve category shall not ordinarily be considered for the award of Free Studentship, as they are entitled to receive the Freeship from the State Government.

(C) COMMON CRITERIA

1) A Candidate has to apply for Merit Scholarship/Free Studentship in the prescribed form provided for the purpose by the University from time to time. Incomplete applications and those received after the prescribed date shall not be entertained.

2) Where there is only final examination at the end of the course, the Merit Scholarship shall be awarded on the basis of the last qualifying University examination.

3) Candidates registered for the research course are entitled to Merit Scholarship/Free Studentship only for the period prescribed for the said course.

4) No payment of Scholarship shall be made unless the candidate has attended minimum 75% lectures and practicals etc. for first term and second term taken together. However, the Vice Chancellor may relax the condition of 75% attendance upto 5% as a special case in an individual case.

5) A Candidate registered for the correspondence course shall not be considered for the award of Merit-Scholarship/Free Studentship.


6) A Candidate registered for the research course shall submit a Certificate along with the bill form from the teacher under whom he/she is registered and forward through the Head of the Institute certifying the satisfactory progress in studies of the Candidate.

7) A Candidate pursuing double specialization of the course shall not be eligible for the award of Merit Scholarship/Free Studentship.

8) The Head of the Institute shall take an undertaking from the Candidate that he/she is not attending any other course of this University or any other University and is also aware that the Scholarship is liable to be forfeited due to his/her irregular attendance, unsatisfactory progress and/or bad conduct.

- The amount to be utilized for the award of Merit Scholarship/Free Studentship shall be calculated as mentioned in this ordinance for the academic year only.
- 10) A Certificate in respect of Merit Scholarship be issued on payment of Rs.100/- if required by the Candidate who has been awarded and found eligible for the amount.
 - 11) All awards not claimed within 12 months from the date of notification of the award shall lapse.
 - 12) The amount to be utilized for the award of Merit Scholarship/ Free Studentship as per clause A (1) and B (1) respectively shall be calculated separately for the candidates registered through college /institution conducting Post Graduate courses in the rural areas independently.
 - 13) The candidates whose marks have been changed (after revaluation), under clause 10 of the 0.237A relating to the revaluation of answer books shall not be considered for the award of Merit Scholarship
 - 14) The Merit Scholarship/ Free Studentship are liable to be withdrawn or forfeited on the ground of irregular attendance, unsatisfactory progress and/or bad conduct.
 - 15) The Selection for the awards of Merit Scholarship/Free Studentship shall be made by the University in respect of inter-collegiate candidates and shall be approved by the Dean of the concerned faculty and the Vice Chancellor.
 - 16) The selection for the awards of Merit Scholarship/Free Studentship to the candidates registered through the University Departments shall be made by the respective Heads of the Departments and shall be approved by the Vice Chancellor.


