Subject: Non-allotment of students for the academic session 2015-16-reg.

Sir,

As you are aware, the National Council for Teacher Education has promulgated the National Council for Teachers Education (Recognition, Norms & Procedure) Regulation, 2014 on 1st December, 2014. The National Council for Teachers Education issued Guidelines after the promulgation of the above Regulations. As per the Guidelines, the existing institutions as well as the institutions whose applications were pending for grant of recognition/permission on the date of notification of NCTE regulations, 2014, were required to submit an affidavit to the effect that they would comply to the provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

The new Regulations provide for various changes in different teacher education programmes, such as duration of the programme, change in unit size, increase in amount of Endowment and Reserve Fund, educational qualifications of faculty etc. National Council for Teacher Education issued directions to issue revised recognition orders to the existing teacher training institutions for B.Ed., B.P.Ed. and M.Ed. programmes, which have submitted affidavits. In case of M.Ed. programme, the institution was also required to submit at least proof of having applied to NAAC for accreditation if accreditation had not taken place.

Accordingly, revised recognition order have been issued t the teacher training institutions for B.Ed., B.P.Ed. and M.Ed. programmes and a copy thereof has been endorsed to the concerned Universities: Further, a list of institutions affiliated to your University for the above programmes and to whom revised recognition orders have been issued, was sent to you. It was also requested in the letter that no student for the academic session 2015-16 be allotted to those institutions which have not been issued revised recognition orders.

In the view of the above, you are requested not to allot students for the academic session 2015-16 to those institutions to whom revised recognition orders have not been issued.

You are also requested to provide a complete list of institutions to whom students have been allotted by you for the above programmes for the academic session 2015-16.

You are also further requested to insist on the institutions affiliated to your University to submit affidavits to NCTE for issue of revised recognition orders failing which the admissions in their institutions will stand null and void.
