Researchers thesis will be scrutinized in this software, If the research is accurate then only researcher thesis will be accepted.

Shodhganga and Shodhgangotri Project of UGC are immensely helpful for the research scholars across the globe and will prevent cheating by attacking the causes. All Universities, who conducts PhD or Mphil programme, are eligible to join Shodhganga by signing a MoU with INFLIBNET Centre.

WHAT IS SHODHGANGA?

The responsibility of hosting, maintaining and making the digital repository Of Indian Electronic Theses and Dissertation (called 'Shodhganga'), accessible to all institutions and universities, is assigned to the INFLIBNET Centre by UGC.

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the scheme are to provide financial assistance for

- i) Providing access to Indian theses and dissertations in open access to world-wide academic community;
- ii) Setting-up of ETD Laboratory in eligible universities;
- iii) Extending access to anti-plagiarism software package in member universities; and
- iv) Funds for digitization of back lists of theses available in universities.

PROCEDURE FOR JOINING SHODHGANGA BY UNIVERSITIES

Universities can formally join Shodhganga initiative by modifying the PhD Ordinance, signing an MoU with the INFLIBNET Centre (Appendix II) and appointing a University Coordinator.
