The summer school of the University of Mumbai was inaugurated at the University's Kalina campus today on 12th May 2014. He opined that research is an activity where it is like rowing a boat where all of us have to be together and for a common goal.

Amongst the other dignitaries were the Dr Anil Gupta, Vice-chairman of National Innovation Foundation was the Guest of honour. He ignited the young minds by quoting examples of school children who could bring about positive changes in the lives of farmers, patients and even people working in the IT sector. He quoted examples of young minds which were very inquisitive and could make a difference to not only their lives but also to those whom they care for. He was of the opinion that science should begin with the empathy and this empathy would change the world.

An MoU was signed between the national Innovation Foundation and University of Mumbai for close interactions in the field of Research and development for young students and teachers from affiliated colleges. Dr Vipin Kumar, Director, NIF in his lucid presentation presented a number of projects from different states of India, which have been patented and commercialised. Dr Naresh Chandra, The pro Vice – chancellor, University of Mumbai emphasised the need of participation in research programs by students from their undergraduate age. He also announced that ten best

participants from the Summer School will be given financial assistance for pursuing their research projects in their colleges. Dr. Rajpal Hande, Director, BCUD in his vote of thanks urged the students to take up research and was of the opinion that the university shall give an all-out support to students pursuing research at the undergraduate and post- graduate levels. He even went further to say that the university research should grow to such an extent that more number students should apply for the patents as now a days the universities are known by its research.
