Sir,

You are kindly aware that Govt. of India established the Wildlife Institute of India in 1982 so as to conduct quality research in wildlife and build capacity of forest officers in the area of Wildlife Management. Accordingly, WII has been conducting "Three Months Certificate Course in Wildlife Management" since 1977. The course is designed to enhance capacity of in-service Range Forest Officers/ Deputy Range Forest Officers or of equivalent ranks working within wildlife and natural resource management sectors, including government and private organization with interest in wildlife conservation and management.

The attached Information Brochure provides the complete details of the above course commencing from 01 November, 2018. This is a paid course for all the participants. The training fee of the course is Rs.3, 20,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Twenty Thousand only) for Indian Participants and this cost will be borne by the concerned State Government/Sponsoring Agency/Participant. The training allowance and to & fro travel expenses of the candidates while joining/returning from the course to their respective parent department would be borne by the Sponsoring Government/Agency and paid to the candidate separately as per their norms. Boarding and lodging, and field expenses for the entire duration of course are included in the course fee. The sponsoring agencies are required to insure sponsored candidates comprehensively for any medical treatment for the duration of the training from 01 November, 2018 to 31 January, 2019.

The medical bill reimbursement, if any, will be made by the respective State Governments/Sponsoring Agency during period above course.

It is, therefore, requested to kindly nominate Range Officers/ Deputy Range Officers or equivalent rank currently serving in your state/college lecturers having work experience in the field of Wildlife Science or Forestry preferably below 35 years of age and not more than 45 years of age as on 01.11.2018 for the above course. Universities/Colleges having forestry or wildlife science as a subject at under-graduate/post-graduate level may also nominate interested faculty for the course. They should be physically fit to withstand the arduous outdoor training programme. The application in enclosed format along with bio-data should reach us latest by 30 September, 2018.
