They are hereby informed that the recommendations made by the Ad-hoc Board of Studies in Architecture at its meeting held on 18th July, 2019 have been accepted by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 26th July, 2019 vide item No.4.50 and that in accordance therewith, the corrections on page No. 30 i.e. 50 marks instead of 150 marks in the syllabus of three years (part time) - Master of Architecture in Landscape, 1.Landscape Conservation and Regional Landscape Planning(Sem. V) and vide item No.4.51 the syllabus of three years (part time) - Master of Architecture in Landscape in the subject Landscape Design as mentioned in the document be called the same throughout the course and they should have the suffix of I, II, III, IV & V to the respective Semesters. However, in the Semester VI, It should read as "Landscape Design - VI (Thesis)" instead of "Landscape Design - III (Thesis)" (The same is available on the University's website www.mu.ac.in).
