 - (ii) Do law conferred rights on dead man? If yes, than enumerates those rights which are conferred on man after his death as well.
- (b) Raj, while cleaning the chimney found a diamond ring inside it. He tried to find the owner, but when he was unsuccessful, he took the ring to the jeweler in order to make some money. The jeweler realizing the actual condition, refused to return it to him not being the real owner.
 - (i) Can Raj recover the ring from the jeweler? Who has got a better title over the ring in the above stated case law?
