Admission to the M.Sc. degree Courses (By Papers) 2018-19

The Heads of the University Departments / the Principals of the affiliated/constituent Colleges in Arts, Commerce & Science and the Coordinator / Assistant Registrar, University Sub Center at Ratnagiri, are hereby notified as under-:

- 1 The Heads, University Departments, Co-ordinator, Ratnagiri sub-centre in Science subjects will complete the admission procedure of M.Sc. (Part I) strictly on merit basis only by following the reservations norms as prescribed by the Government of Maharashtra and University from time to time:
- All the Principals of the Colleges having the courses for M.Sc. on unaided basis (including Physics, Chemistry and Biochemistry) except Botany, and Zoology, Microbiology will complete the admission procedure strictly on merit basis by following the reservations norms as prescribed by the University of Mumbai from time to time, on or before 18th August, 2018.
- Admissions to the M.Sc. degree courses in the subjects of Chemistry (Aided), Physics (Aided) Biochemistry (Aided) and Botany, Zoology, Microbiology (Aided & Unaided) for the Academic Year 2018 2019 will be made by the Post Graduate Section of the University.

Students are requested to collect the prescribed format from and submit the form consisting of four Sections and get the same verified from the Post Graduate Section Room No.130, University of Mumbai, Fort Campus, along with all documents in supports of marks at T.Y. B.Sc. (V & VI Sem) and certificate in support of claim to seats under reserved categories. The time for submission form on all working days will be 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. & 1.30 p.m to 4.00 p.m. except Second and Fourth Saturday and Holidays.

If their personal Marks Statement is not available presently, the students of Colleges and Institutes affiliated to Mumbai University can submit the admission Form along with these certified common marks Statement of the College. Such students will be required to produce Original Statement of marks at the time of Counseling.

- 4 The Centralized Admission Procedure (CAP) for the M.Sc. Degree course on Aided basis in the subjects of 1) Organic Chemistry 2) Inorganic Chemistry 3) Analytical Chemistry 4) Physical Chemistry and Physics will be done by the Post Graduate Section at University of Mumbai, Room No- 130, Fort and on Unaided basis will be as under:-
 - A) All colleges having UN-AIDED M.Sc. Chemistry and Unaided Physics programme will give the admissions on merit by following reservation norms declared by University of Mumbai from time to time, and will declare their own schedule of admissions but all admissions should be completed on or before 18th August 2018.

The criteria to be taken into consideration for merit list for University admissions and college admissions will be as follows in order of preference:-

I) For Mumbai University Students:

- a) The students who have been declared in and above without grace marks with as a single major subject out of 1200 (Sem V & VI).
- b) The CGPA will be considered, if the marks are equal.
- c) The students who have been declared passed with grace marks / with as a single major subject out of 1200. (Sem V & VI).
- d) The students offering two major subjects, Chemistry as one of the subject at T.Y.B.Sc. be admitted in order of merit by considering marks secured in Chemistry at T.Y.B.Sc. only.
- e) In case there is a tie in a), b) c) or (d) aggregate marks without grace marks out of 1200. (Sem V & VI)
- f) In case there is a tie in a), b), c) or d) then marks in theory out of 800 without grace marks. (Sem V & VI)

There will be one common merit list for all the students in each subject for the admissions to be made by the Post Graduate Section of the University of Mumbai. The final merit list will be displayed on the website of the University and also on the Notice Board of the Post Graduate Studies Section, University of Mumbai, Fort, Mumbai – 400 032. The merit list will also be mailed to the Colleges provided; mail address is communicated to the University.

II) For other University Students:

Candidates belonging to Universities other than University of Mumbai should submit self attested Xerox copies of all the three years B.Sc. Marksheets.
