- 1) Students of University of Mumbai seeking admission to M.Sc. degree for University quota seats are requested to visit for M.Sc. admissions to University of Mumbai, Post Graduate Section, First Floor, Room No. 130, Fort, Mumbai 400 032.(All information regarding admission is available on our University's website i.e. www.mu.ac.in.)
- 2) Students who are seeking admission to M.Sc. degree course are required to submit one set of attested photo copies of T.Y.B.Sc. (Sem V&VI.) Marksheet with their originals/Statement of marks issued by University and attested by Principal/Vice Principal if students not having marksheet alongwith application form mentioning therein percentage of marks obtained in the major subject or major subjects at T.Y.B.Sc. Examination
- 3) Gap Certificate on (Rs. 100/- Bond paper) if there is gap after passing B. Sc degree course. There is no need to deduct 3% marks since it is a semester pattern from students having a gap.
- 4) Attach copy of the marriage certificate if the name is changed after the marriage.
- 5) The filling of form is compulsory for all the students desirous of admission to M.Sc.Degree of University of Mumbai in (1) Botany (2) Microbiology, (3) Zoology (Aided & Unaided) (4) Bio-Chemistry & (5) Physics (Aided).
- 6) Students are requested to submit form consisting of four Sections and get this verify from the Post Graduate Section of University of Mumbai, Fort Campus, along with all documents in supports of marks at T.Y. B.Sc. (SemV & VI .) and certificate in support of claim to seats under reserved category. The time for submission of form on all working days will be 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. & 1.30 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. except second and fourth Saturday.

- 7) All the candidates claiming the reservation under various reserved category should produce "Caste Certificate" in the name of the candidate issued by the Competent Authority of the Maharashtra Government clearly mentioning the Category of the candidate and also the remark that the caste is considered as Backward Class in the state of Maharashtra at the time of submission the admission form, failing which, the candidate will not be able to claim seat under reserved category.
- The candidates belonging to DT/NT, OBC and SBC categories should submit latest "Non Creamy Layer Certificate" issued by Sub Divisional Officer/Deputy Collector of the district in addition to the caste certificate. In case if these candidates are not able to produce the latest "Non Creamy Layer Certificate" at the time of submission of application form, then such candidates will be treated as OPEN category candidates.

Candidates belonging to Universities Other than University of Mumbai should submit self attested Xerox copies of all the three years B.Sc. Marksheets.

- 9) 03 % seats are reserved for the candidates who have passed B.Sc. from the University other than University of Mumbai.
- 10) The category of specially disabled students should mention in the form and submit required certificates issued by the Competent Authority.
