COURSE ELIGIBILITY



B.A. (Three Years)

F. Y. B. A.

II (H.S.C.) from Maharashtra State Board OR equivalent Exam from other state, with English as compulsory subject **(As per the ordinance O.2138)**

OR

3 years Diploma from MSBTE OR other boards recognized as equivalent **(As per equivalence on 24/8/2010)**

OR

10+2 years ITI course. **(As per the circular of Higher & Technical Education Department क्र. व्हीओसी - २०१२ / ५९१/ प्र.क्र.२४५ (अ) / व्यशि -४, दिनांक २८/९/२०१२)**

S. Y. B. A.

Passed in F.Y.B.A.

OR

ATKT in not more than two subjects in F.Y.B.A. as per (annual pattern system)

OR

A student shall be allowed to keep term (ATKT) in Second Year only if student fails in not more than two subjects in each of semester I & semester II of First Year (Semester pattern system of affiliated colleges of University of Mumbai)
Student is require to pass the KT subject in the parent college.

OR

Passed in all the subjects of F.Y.B.A. for the students of other Universities.

COURSE ELIGIBILITY



T. Y. B. A.

Passed in F.Y.B.A. & S.Y.B.A.

OR

ATKT in not more than two subjects in F.Y.B.A. provided S.Y.B.A. is passed in full (annual pattern system)

ATKT in not more than two subjects in S.Y.B.A. (ATKT not more than 300 marks) provided F.Y.B.A. is passed in full (annual pattern system)

OR

A student shall be allowed to keep term (ATKT) in Third Year only if student fails in not more than two subjects in each of semester I and semester II of First Year and student must have passed Second Year semester III and semester IV in full.

Student is require to pass the KT subject in the parent college.

OR

A student shall be allowed to keep term (ATKT) in Third Year only if student fails in not more than two subjects in each semester III and semester IV of Second Year and student must have passed First Year semester I and semester II in full.

Student is require to pass the KT subject in the parent college.

OR

Passed in F.Y.B.A. & S.Y.B.A. for the students of other Universities.

COURSE ELIGIBILITY



M. A. Course & Eligibility

M.A. (Two Years)

Part- I	Any Bachelor's Degree in any subject from a Statutory University. (As per the ordinance O.2237)
Part- II	Passed in M.A. Part I (on or before the commencement of M.A. Part Exam. Students will not be permitted to appear for M.A. Part II examination unless he/she has passed the Part I examination, previously

STANDARD OF PASSING



- × Exam pattern is yearly, 100 marks for each paper.
- × **Minimum passing** marks require in every head is **40%**

LECTURE DETAILS



- × Lectures are conducted at PCP (Personal Contact Programme) Centers.
- × Each lecture is for 2 hours each.
- × There are a total of 8 sessions i.e 16 hours per subject.
- × Sessions are conducted on weekend, or in the evenings on weekdays.

EXAMINATION



- × Annual Pattern
- × Held between April to June
- × Maximum Marks - 100
- × Passing Marks- 40
- × Duration for each paper- 3 hours
