→ PGDORM Part-II Students: - Students should scan and upload their Part –I passed / failed marksheet, Part-II fail marksheet and Degree marksheet for those students who had not appeared for Part-II, Examination Bachelor degree convocation certificate.

5. On completion of process no need to submit hard copy of Examination form anywhere.
6. Students should fill up the Examination Forms personally & see to it that all details are correct before taking printout.
