Mumbai University established a Sub-Campus at Ratnagiri of Ratnagiri District in 1989. The Ratnagiri Sub-Campus was established to co-ordinate with colleges of Ratnagiri and Sindhudurg districts. Mumbai University started Master's courses in 2002 at Ratnagiri Sub-Campus in keeping the view of affordable education. The first master's course established in 2002 at Ratnagiri Sub-Campus was M. Sc. in Environmental Science. It currently offers master's courses in three science disciplines viz. Environmental science, Chemistry and Zoology (Oceanography).

- (2) No institution is allowed to enrol students for the M.Sc.(Part I) course in a subject in which there is no recognized teacher attached to it. Applicants should, therefore, ascertain that there is at least one recognized teacher in the subject which they desire to offer in the institution/s to which admission is desired.
- (3) An applicant must have offered one / two Major subject/s at the B.Sc.examination, the subject which he desires to offer for the M.Sc. examination.
- (4) (a) The marks obtained by the students in the Major subject at the Third Year B.Sc. examinations (Sem. VI) of this University will be considered for deciding merit for admission to the M.Sc. Part I course in the subject.
- (b) that students passing the Third Year B.Sc. examination with two major subjects will be considered eligible to apply for admission to the M.Sc. Part I course in either of the major subjects.
- (c) that the merit of candidates for admission to the M.Sc.Part I course in different, subjects will be decided on the basis of the aggregate marks obtained by them in the major subject at the Third Year B.Sc. examinations. However, students securing First Class at the Final Year B.Sc. examination will be placed over the students securing the Second Class and those securing the Second Class will be placed over the students securing the Pass Class.
- (d) that if the percentage of marks obtained by students in the major subject is the same, the students offering the said major subject with six units at the Third Year B.Sc. examination will be placed over those passing the said examination with two major subjects each consisting of three units.
- (5) An applicant who has passed the B.Sc. examination of other University with three Science subjects must have offered at that examination the subject (Major) in which he seeks admission to the M.Sc. (Part I) course.
- (6) (a) No individual intimation will be sent to students selected for admission.
- (b) The list of students selected for admission to the course will be put up on Notice Board of the respective Department and University Main Building, Fort, Mumbai – 400 032.
- (c) The Registration Fee for the course is ₹/- and the Tuition Fee is ₹/- per annum in all the subjects except in Computer Science. The registration fee for the Computer Science ₹/- for the course and the, tuition fee is ₹/- per annum. The fees paid by students for admission to the course is not refundable except as provided under the rules relating to the refund of fees.
- (d) A student selected for admission to the M.Sc. (Part I) course in the subject will have to pay the tuition fees as well as the fee for registration as a Post-graduate student in the Accounts Section of the University Office as specified on the Notice Board on or before the date mentioned in the list of the selected candidates, failing which he will forfeit his claim to the seat allotted to him, Under no circumstances, a student who has failed to avail himself of the admission before the date as mentioned in the list of selected candidates will be considered for a seat in the second list.

- (e) Students selected for admission according to their second, third, fourth or fifth preference of the branch of Chemistry, will be subsequently considered for admission according to their preferences, for the vacancies, if any, that may arise on account of the selected students not availing themselves of the admissions. Such of the selected students as are not desirous of availing of their preferences indicated by them in the application, would give in writing to the Head of the University Department of Chemistry immediately, that their other preferences should not be considered for subsequent admission. If they do not do so and if they are selected subsequently for the other branch according to their preferences they will forfeit the seat already allotted to them in the earlier list.
- (f) The vacancies that may arise on account of the, selected students not availing themselves of the admissions before the aforesaid date will be filled up by the allotment thereof to the students on the waiting list. A list of such students will be put up on Notice Board within a week.
- (g) Students from the waiting list who are selected for admission and whose names are included in the subsequent list will have to pay the tuition and the registration fees referred to above on or before the date mentioned in the list of the selected candidate, failing which they will forfeit claims of admission to the course.
- (7) Person who are graduates of Universities other than the University of Mumbai, are required to obtain a certificate of eligibility from the Registrar of the University of Mumbai before they can be admitted to the University Department, a constituent college or a constituent recognised institution.
- (8) Applications must be accompanied by certified copies of the statements of marks obtained by the applicants at the B.Sc. degree examination, certified by the Principal of a constituent college / the Head of a recognized Institution/s Member of the Senate of this University, or a Magistrate, in the case of the B.Sc. (Three-Year Course) the marks of all the three years must be accompanied.
- (9) No intimation will be sent to those who are not selected for admission.
- (10) Incomplete applications will not be considered.
