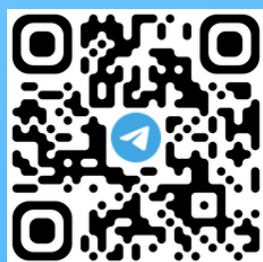

- Referencing should be according to a APA referencing style
