**PROGRAMME OF THE FIRST YEAR M.C.A. (Sem.-I) CBCS
(THREE YEAR POST GRADUATE COURSE) ONLINE EXAMINATION**

(As per the circular issued by the University of Mumbai vide Circular No. Exam./DBOEE/ICC/2021-22-16 dated 24th September, 2021 regarding conduction of MCQs type online examinations for the courses offered by IDOL, University of Mumbai.)

The duration for online examination shall be TWO AND HALF HOUR for 80 Marks (20 Marks for MCQ half hour & 60 Marks for Descriptive type exam with Two hour)

As per the decision of Statutory Bodies (BOEE, AC and MC), University of Mumbai has adopted the format of online Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQ) and theory exam for external evaluation of Fresh students and their backlog / repeater examinations.

MCQ, with due versatility, validity and reliability, are the effective and efficiency way to assess learning outcomes.

The students must ensure that they make themselves properly aware of the syllabus, paper pattern, time table schedule prescribed by the IDOL and should make requisite arrangements (Smartphones, Laptop/Tab/Desktop/any other gadget, Internet Connectivity) to appear for the online examination.

The online examination shall be conducted on Desktop, Laptop, Palmtop, Mobile, Smart or Android mobile phones. Since this is an online examination, there will not be any revaluation.

Students should refer to and follow instructions given by IDOL and University. Do not believe in message spread on any social media platform.

Students should not resort to use of unfair means while attempting the examination. University/IDOL will initiate action for use of unfair means as per University rules.

- 1) Online Examination will be conducted on University of Mumbai, Learning Management Platform- Eklavya
- 2) all students are hereby informed that they have to choose HALF HOUR SLOT for MCQ and TWO HOUR SLOT for Theory exam (subjective questions) between 09.00 a.m. to 01.00 p.m. to appear for the online examinations in their respective subject.
- 3) Students are also informed that if suppose he/she has logged at 12:30 p.m. in such Case the students will get only half an hour time to appear for the online examination . Students will be fully responsible for the same.
- 4) 10 Minutes extra time will be given for theory exam to only scan and upload the answer sheet.

- 8) Only .jpg, .jpeg, .pdf file will be supported to upload your answers. Answers will be marked as zero if any student is typing the answers online or answers typed in any other softcopy format is uploaded. Only handwritten answers will be considered.
